
NORTH or SOUTH ELEVATION





at No 1 Dairy Paddock Road, Stanley.






LOCATION of PROPOSED HEN HOUSE (NOT TO SCALE)



PROPOSED SITE for ERECTION of DIESEL OIL TANKS


