BIGGS, James Samuel	1891 May 09	50	Born in Woolwich, England. Son of James & Margaret. Husband of Harriet. Arrived January 1842. TB
LYSE, Obadiah	1893 Jan 24	43	Ex 69th Company Royal Marines. Blacksmith. Widower of Harriet. Cardiac asthenia
BIGGS, Mabel Eleanor	1895 Nov	14 mths	Daughter of James Thomas & Rose. Granddaughter of James Samuel & Harriet. Congestion of the lungs after influenza
BIGGS, Rose Emily Margaret	1896 Nov 14	30	Wife of James Thomas. Daughter-in-law of James S & Harriet. Acute gastritis
HALLIDAY, John George	1910 Jan 03	2y 11mths	Son of George & Janet. Grandson of John & Janet GOODWIN. Died at Dunbar from acute gastro-enteritis caused by mushrooms
GOODWIN, Annie Sarah	1912 Sep 01	35	2 nd wife of George. Daughter-in-law of John & Janet. Puerperal septicaemia
GOODWIN, John	1925 Nov 24	84	From Scotland. Arrived 1866. Husband of Janet
JOHNSON, Henry	1927 Feb 09		Buried at Roy Cove Feb 1927 by Dr Craddock
JOHNSON, Amy Beatrice	1937 Aug 14	3 mths	Daughter of Alfred & Regina. Died at The Boundary from Broncho-pneumonia
ALAZIA, Doreen Selina	1947 May 22	2 yrs 11mths	Daughter of Albert & Thora. Broncho-pneumonia
BINNIE, Priscilla Fay	1949 Aug 13	1y 6mths	Daughter of Albert & Eileen. Septicaemia & acute streptococcal tonsillitis
ALAZIA, Albert Faulkner	1994 Sep 04	80	Buried next to his daughter, Doreen
