

ADAMS FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.

Francis Edward “Frank” ADAMS was born ? (*not in the Falkland Islands*).

Francis was married to **Elizabeth MORGAN** (*not in the Falkland Islands*).

Francis and Elizabeth arrived 16 April 1893 on board the *Neko* from Europe. Frank was appointed a constable 16 April 1893 on agreement with the Crown Agents on an annual salary of £60 with a house allowance. In 1894 he also received wages as assistant printer in the Government Printing Office.

Frank retired in 1897. On 17 April 1897 Francis, Elizabeth and their family departed for England on board the *Luxor*.

The family returned 20 October 1897 on board the *Ammon* and departed 10 November 1898 for West Falkland on board the *Hornet*.

Francis and his family departed 30 April 1902 on board the *Liguria* bound for Liverpool.

FIRST GENERATION

Children of Francis and Elizabeth ADAMS:

1. **William Herbert ADAMS** born 4 August 1893 in Stanley and baptised 30 October 1893 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as police constable.
2. **Annie Blossie ADAMS** born 21 December 1894 and baptised 4 February 1895 by Christ Church Cathedral.
3. **Elizabeth Alice ADAMS** born 9 August 1896 and baptised 6 October 1896 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as police constable.
4. **Francis George ADAMS** born 23 October 1899 and baptised **Francis George Vernon ADAMS** 29 December 1899 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as printer.
