BINNIE FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Any variations which may occur in the spellings of names are recorded as written in the records at the time.

William BINNIE was born 13 December 1847 to **William BINNIE**, a coalminer/blacksmith and **Marion SMITH** née **RUSSELL**. (*This was her second marriage and she had two children by her first marriage, Thomas born 1843 and Margaret born 1845).*

Marion POPE was born 8 October 1847 to James POPE, a coalminer, and Marion POPE née NEILSON.

William BINNIE (*junior*), tailor, married **Marion POPE**, a domestic servant, 18 April 1868 at Waterloo, Lanarkshire, Scotland. The witnesses were Nisbet Pope and Isabella Henderson. At the time of their marriage Marion's father was listed as deceased and her mother had remarried and was now **Marion BEVERIDGE**.

William and Marion emigrated with their children to the Falkland Islands from Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire, Scotland circa 1882/1883. Family information list them as arriving on the "Dennis Brundit". If this is correct and given the birth dates of their last child born in Scotland and their first child born in the Falklands they would have arrived in Stanley from London either on 4 May 1883 or 28 October 1884.

William died 27 March 1921 and is buried in Grave li859. Marion died 26 May 1929 and is buried in Grave L993.

Children of William and Marion BINNIE:

- 1. **William BINNIE** born 9 March 1869 at Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire, Scotland. Died 14 May 1892 and is buried in Grave A61.
- 2. James George "Jim" BINNIE born 2 November 1870 at Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire, Scotland. Married Elizabeth Margaret PAICE 14 April 1893 at Port Howard according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Edwin C Aspinall Assistant Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Nathaniel Thomas Paice, Alice Paice, James Bishop and Clara Cheek. Elizabeth died 9 October 1939 at Port Howard and is buried there. James died 29 May 1941 and is buried in Grave L1185.
- 3. Marion BINNIE born 5 August 1872 at Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire, Scotland. Married George Bond PAICE, a carter of Stanley and The Chartres, 29 June 1898 in the Parish Church according to the Rites & Ceremonies of the Established Church after Banns by Lowther E Brandon MA Dean & Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Nathaniel Thomas Paice and Thomas Binnie. Marion died 22 August 1927 and is buried at Chartres. George died 18 September 1938 and is buried in Grave L1127.
- 4. **Thomas BINNIE** born 26 January 1875 at Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire, Scotland. Died 18 February 1946 and is buried in Grave P1316. [Obituary FI Weekly News Feb 21 1946]
- 5. Elizabeth "Ligg" BINNIE born 11 April 1877 at Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire, Scotland. Married William James "Jim" WILSON, age 25 and a police constable, 9 January 1896 in the Parish Church according to the Rites & Ceremonies of the Established Church after Banns by Lowther E Brandon MA Dean & Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Thomas Binnie and Marion Binnie. William's father was recorded as Robert Wilson, plumber, and Elizabeth's father was recorded as William Binnie, tailor. Elizabeth, age 75 and a widow, died in Stanley 14 August 1952 and was buried 17 August 1952 in Grave 1492.
- 6. Margaret "Maggie" BINNIE born 22 July 1879 at Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire, Scotland. Appointed Post Office Lady Assistant 21 August 1899 [FI Gazette 7 September 1899 attached] Married Franz Fritz LELLMAN, (anglicised to Francis Frederick on his son's marriage certificate) a painter, 11 October 1908 in Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by C Rome Hall, Assistant Cathedral Chaplain. The witnesses were Edward Beveridge Binnie, Victor Joseph Lellman and Sarah McGill. Margaret died 15 November 1951 and is buried in Grave 1469.
- 7. **Nisbet Pope BINNIE** born 3 August 1882 at Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire, Scotland. Occupation tailor and merchant. Married **Mary Jane PERGOLIS** 18 November 1908 at the house of William Binnie, Stanley by Special Licence by C Rome Hall, Assistant Cathedral Chaplain. The witnesses were Margaret Lellman and Thomas Binnie. Nisbet died 29 April 1956 and is buried in Grave Q1570. Mary died 13 June 1971 and is buried in Grave U2165.
- 8. **Edward Beveridge "Ted" BINNIE** born 8 October 1884 at Stanley, Falkland Islands. Appointed temporary magistrate and coroner for the South Shetlands and Graham's Land from 1 October 1912 [FI Gazette 2 December 1912 attached] Married **Margrethe LARSEN** (*not in the Falklands*) 17 October 1923. Edward died 27 June 1956 in Norway.
- 9. **Sarah BINNIE** born 5 August 1887 at Stanley, Falkland Islands. Married **John Wright McGILL**, a butcher, 31 May 1908 in Christ Church Cathedral by C Rome Hall, Assistant Cathedral Chaplain. The witnesses were Margaret Binnie and Nisbet Binnie. John died 20 March 1950 and is buried in Grave L1424. Sarah died 12 January 1970 and is buried in Grave T2148.

Children of James (2) and Elizabeth BINNIE:

- 1. **James George BINNIE** born 5 March 1894 at Stanley. Shepherd. Married **Muriel Avis Elizabeth "Dolly" MAY** 8 July 1916 at Chartres. Muriel died 2 August 1937 at Chartres and is buried there. James died 10 April 1963 at Chartres and was buried there. [Obituary FI Monthly Review 6 May 1963 attached]
- 2. **Marion Anne Elizabeth BINNIE** born 6 September 1895 at Chartres. Married **Thomas Watson CAMPBELL**, clerk, 19 July 1923 at Christ Church Cathedral. Thomas died 14 January 1947 and is buried in Grave P 1336.
- William Nathaniel "Buttons" BINNIE born 21 December 1897. Labourer and dairyman. Married May AITKEN 1 June 1927 at Christ Church Cathedral. William died 6 January 1961 and is buried in Grave S 1687.
- 4. Thomas BINNIE born 8 April 1903. Appointed second assistant printer 1 May 1920 [FI Gazette 1 June 1920 attached] Also worked as a lighthouse keeper and sailor. Married Emily Jane GOSS 22 July 1924 at Christ Church Cathedral. Thomas was presumed drowned at Volunteer Lagoon while proceeding by pram from the schooner "Peronelle" on 22 October 1933. (see Penguin 4 & 23 Nov 1933). Body not found. Emily married (2) Marklin Lawrence GLEADELL 5 November 1935 in the Registrar's Office, Stanley.

Children of Marion (3) and George PAICE:

- 1. **Marion Sarah PAICE** born 20 November 1899 at Port Howard. Married **Gordon STEWART** 27 July 1921at Chartres. Marion died 12 August 1937 at Chartres and is buried there. Gordon died 22 July 1961 at Rincon Grande and is buried in Grave S1698.
- 2. **Georgina Bond PAICE** born 3 September 1902 at Port Howard. Married **Arthur George ETHERIDGE** 17 May 1930 at Christ Church Cathedral. He died 8 April 1970 at Stanley and is buried in Grave T2153. She died 24 May 1986 and is buried in Grave T2154.
- 3. **William Nathaniel PAICE** born 16 September 1905 at Hill Cove. Married **Annie PORTER** 23 September 1939 at Fox Bay. Worked as sub-manager at Dunnose Head. Died 16 April 1960 at Dunnose Head and is buried at Fox Bay Village. Annie married (2) **Henry William BETTS** 29 March 1963 at Pebble Island.

Children of Elizabeth (5) and William WILSON:

- 1. Ruth Stella WILSON born 7 September 1899 on West Point Island and baptised 2 July 1900 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as labourer. Ruth was married to Thomas Oscar DETTLEFF, a carpenter, 16 August 1923 at Christ Church Cathedral by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Ernest Dettleff and Hilda Wilson. Thomas' father was recorded as John Dettleff, butcher, and Ruth's father was recorded as William James Wilson, painter. Thomas and Ruth went on holiday to the UK in 1946.
- 2. Hilda Mabel Kathleen WILSON born 1 April 1901 and baptised 13 Mary 1901 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as police constable. Hilda was married to Norman Alfred PAGE, a lighthouse keeper at Cape Pembroke, 17 January 1928 at Christ Church Cathedral by Frederick S Vaughan, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were N Binnie

and S Dettleff. Norman's father was recorded as Henry Richard Page, master, Trinity House Service, and Hilda's father was recorded as William James Wilson, painter. Norman was born 1 July 1900 at Ramsgate, Kent, England. Hilda emigrated to the UK with Norman in 1931.

Child of Margaret (6) and Franz LELLMAN:

 Edward Frances "Bats" LELLMAN born 19 October 1914 at Stanley. Occupation Assistant Treasurer, Civil Service. Married Winifred May BRIGGINSHAW, a state registered nurse (born in Dunstable, Bedfordshire, England), 19 October 1948 at the Nonconformist Church (Tabernacle), Stanley by Walter Forrest McWhan, Nonconformist Minister. Witnesses J Bound and A R Draycott. They emigrated to the UK in 1957.

- 1. **Muriel Denora BINNIE** born 4 April 1909 at Stanley. Died 13 October 1960 at Stanley and is buried in Grave Q1681.
- 2. **Edith Mary BINNIE** born 9 April 1911 at Stanley. Died 19 June 1917 of cerebro spinal meningitis. Buried in Grave D817 [Obituary CM July 1917 attached]
- 3. **Sybil Grace BINNIE** born 21 August 1914 at Stanley. Married **Ernest Falkland LUXTON**, a labourer, 25 August 1934 at Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by Harold E Lumsdale, Dean of Christ Church. The witnesses were Nisbet Binnie, E S Smith and C M Newing. Ernest died 19 April 1999 and is buried in Grave V3298.
- 4. **Terence William BINNIE** born 12 November 1922. Terence, a merchant, was married to **Jean Sarah PARRIN** 29 Dec 1956 at the Office of the Registrar General, Stanley by Harold Bennett, Registrar General. Witnesses E F Luxton and S G Luxton.
