

BROWN FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.

George William BROWN was born in Ireland in 1844 and was married to **Margaret Stevens ROGERS** (*not in the Falkland Islands*).

George was principal lighthouse keeper at Cape Pembroke Lighthouse from 1 March 1871 to 1877.

FIRST GENERATION:

Children of George and Margaret BROWN:

1. **Edith Mary BROWN** born 3 July 1871 and baptised 14 September 1871 at Cape Pembroke by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as Principal Lightkeeper, Cape Pembroke Lighthouse.
2. **Mable BROWN** born 17 July 1873 and baptised 7 October 1873 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as lighthouse keeper, Cape Pembroke.
3. **Edmond George BROWN** born 16 March 1875 and baptised 23 August 1875 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as lighthouse keeper, Cape Pembroke.
4. **James Stanley BROWN** born 17 June 1877. His father's occupation was recorded as light keeper, Cape Pembroke.
