CAMPBELL FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.

Walter Scott CAMPBELL, age 23, left Southampton on board the *Boyne* 9 June 1873 for Montevideo. He then took the *Black Hawk* to Stanley, Falkland Islands. [H22; D16, pg 82: FIC C1; desp 453] James was working at Bodie Creek, possibly from March 1871.

Walter, a shepherd living in Stanley, was married to **Elizabeth PRICE**, living in Stanley, 10 February 1897 in the house of W R Hardy Stanley according to the Rites & Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Dean & Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Arthur Hardy and Isabella G Ogilvie. Walter's father was recorded as John Campbell, Manager, and Elizabeth's father was recorded as Roger Price, framer.

Walter died 28 June 1912, age 58, and was buried 3 July 1912 in Grave G747. Elizabeth died 10 October 1937, age 67, and was buried 12 October 1937 in Grave G1116.

FIRST GENERATION:

Children of Walter and Elizabeth CAMPBELL:

- Isabella CAMPBELL born 25 February 1899 and baptised 4 May 1899 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as shepherd. Isabella died 22 August 1912, age 13 ½, from peritonitis and was buried 25 August 1911 in Grave G750.
- 2. John Markham CAMPBELL born 29 August 1900 and baptised 21 November 1900 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as shepherd. In 1930 John, a labourer, went to the UK to attend a Bisley shooting meeting. John, a sergeant in the FIDF living in Stanley, was married to Sylvia SUMMERS 4 May 1943 at Christ Church Cathedral by Banns by Gerald K Lowe, Senior Chaplain. The witnesses were Vere F Summers and John F Summers. Sylvia's father was recorded as John Falkland Summers, baker. Sylvia died 31 January 1951, age 50, and was buried 2 February 1951 in Grave 1446. John, a painter and decorator, died 9 October 1963 in Stanley, age 63, and was buried 12 October 1963 in Grave Q1744.
- 3. Ray CAMPBELL born 19 February 1904 at Teal Inlet and baptised 19 March 1905 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as shepherd. Ray, a painter, was married to Ethel SUMMERS (sister of Sylvia), 9 September 1935 at the Registrar's Office, Stanley by Special Licence by A R Hoare, Ag Registrar General. The witnesses were John Markham Campbell and Sylvia Summers. Ethel's father was recorded as John Falkland Summers, baker.
