

DEAN FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Any variations which may occur in the spellings of names are recorded as written in the records at the time.

John Markham DEAN was born 4 September 1815 to John DEAN and Frances DEAN formerly MARKHAM. He was orphaned at age 9 and brought up by his aunt, a housekeeper to George WHITINGTON.

John was married to **Charlotte MILLYARD** in 1834.

John was employed by John Bull WHITINGTON, brother to George, and arrived at Port Louis with his family 17 November 1840.

In the January 1842 census John was recorded as being age 26, a native of England, clerk & foreman, Protestant and living in Falkland House. Charlotte was recorded as being age 25 and a native of England living in Falkland House.

John leased Pebble Island, etc in 1862.

John and his family returned to England in 1864 and settled at Southampton House, Lordship Road, Stoke Newington.

John purchased Pebble Island, etc in 1869.

Charlotte died at Stoke Newington in 1881.

John, age 89, died in London 17 October 1903. [Obituary FIM Xmas 1903] [In Dictionary of Falklands Biography]

FIRST GENERATION:

Children of John and Charlotte DEAN:

1. **George Markham DEAN** born in 1837 in London, England. George arrived at Port Louis with his family 17 November 1840. George was married to **Orissa Catherine Anne WOOTTON** in 1862 (*not in the Falkland Islands*). George and Orissa were passengers on board the ss *Memphis* which left London March 1888. George, age 51 and a merchant & native of London, England, died on board the ss *Memphis* 1 April 1888 from hepatic cirrhosis, exhaustion & coma and was buried 22 April 1888 in Grave D690. The Falkland Islands Company Ltd purchased his store, property and vessels in 1888. Orissa built Cemetery Cottage in 1909 in memory of her husband and godchildren Beatrice Mary Lewis and George Thomas Luxton. Orissa, age 80, died in Stanley 10 September 1920 and was buried 16 September 1920 in Grave D851. [Obituary FIM Dec 1920 & FIM Aug 1921] [In Dictionary of Falklands Biography]

2. **Frances “Fanny” DEAN** born in 1838 (*not in the Falkland Islands*). Frances arrived at Port Louis with her family 17 November 1840.
3. **Emma Falkland DEAN** born 20 June 1842 at Port Louis. Emma, age 4 months, died in the Town of Anson August 1842 and was buried 22 August 1842 at Port Louis.
4. **Emily Oakshot DEAN** born 4 December 1844 at Port Louis and baptised in Stanley 17 February 1854 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as merchant.
5. **Charles Montague “Monte” DEAN** born 1 February 1847 in Stanley and baptised 17 February 1854 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as merchant. Charles was married to **Annie Sophia CARPENTER** in 1876 (*not in the Falkland Islands*). Annie and her three children departed 23 May 1890 on board the *Totmes* and Charles

departed 21 July 1890 on board the *Denderah* for England. Charles, age 54, died at Arkly House, High Barnett, Hertfordshire, England 6 November 1901.

6. **Charlotte Milyard DEAN** born 16 February 1848 in Stanley and baptised 17 February 1854 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as merchant.
7. **Matilda DEAN** born 20 August 1849 in Stanley and baptised 17 February 1854 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as merchant.
8. **Ralph DEAN** born in 1852 and baptised 17 February 1854 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as merchant
9. **John Hall DEAN** born 1 February 1853 in Stanley and baptised 17 February 1854 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as merchant. John, a sheep farmer living in Stanley, was married to **Eliza Mary THOMAS**, living in Stanley, 29 May 1886 in the Parish Church according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were John Key Thomas and Elizabeth Thomas. John's father was recorded as John Markham Dean, merchant, and Eliza's father was recorded as John Key Thomas, master mariner. John bought Keppel Island, Passage Island, Dry Island & Bold Island from the South American Missionary Society 10 July 1911. John died 6 July 1920 at Windemere, 8 Woodberry Down, Stoke Newington, Middlesex, England. [In Dictionary of Falklands Biography] Eliza died in 1937 (*not in the Falkland Islands*).

SECOND GENERATION:

Children of Charles (5) and Annie DEAN:

1. **Florence Emily DEAN** born 14 September 1877 in Stanley and baptised 1 March 1878 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as merchant. Florence, of Arkley House, Barnet, was married to **Henry Edmund KINGSFORD** of Chelsea, 30 July 1903 at the Parish Church, Chipping, Barnet, England by the Rev J Bond Lee. Henry's father was Henry Baldock Kingsford, deceased, and Florence's father was recorded as C Montague Dean, deceased. [FIM Nov 1903]
2. **Annie Maude DEAN** born 30 January 1879 in Stanley and baptised 28 December 1880 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as merchant. Annie was married to **Charles James Stanton HARCOURT** 30 November 1905 in Sydney, New South Wales, Australia and in December 1908 was living in Wellington, New Zealand.
3. **William Markham DEAN** born 17 March 1881 in Stanley and baptised 14 April 1881 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as merchant.
4. **Harold DEAN** born 1 January 1883 in Stanley and baptised 21 March 1883 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as merchant. Harold died in 1905 (*not in the Falkland Islands*).
5. **Edith Constance DEAN** born 7 December 1885 in Stanley and baptised **Edith Caroline DEAN** 21 August 1887 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as merchant. In 1909 Edith was living at Montague Mansions, Baker Street, London.
6. **Girl DEAN** born 23 March 1890 in Stanley. Stillborn.

Children of John (9) and Eliza DEAN:

1. **Millyard Charlotte Elizabeth DEAN** born 31 March 1887. Her father's occupation was recorded as sheep farmer.
2. **George Thomas "Bill" DEAN** born 11 September 1888 in Stanley and baptised 7 October 1888 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as sheep farmer. George left August 1915 with his brother John to join the Royal Field Artillery. [FIM Aug 1915] George, a lieutenant, arrived 8 December 1919 on board the *Orcoma*. George was married to **Evelyn CHALLIS** in 1928 (*not in the Falkland Islands*). George died 27 January 1954 in Tunbridge Wells. [In Dictionary of Falklands Biography]
3. **Matilda May DEAN** born 16 May 1890 and baptised 27 July 1890 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as farmer.
4. **Frances Emily DEAN** born 17 December 1891 and baptised 8 May 1892 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as sheep farmer.

5. **John Wycombe “Jack” DEAN** born 29 November 1893 and baptised 8 December 1893 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as farmer. John left August 1915 with his brother George to join the Royal Field Artillery. [FIM Aug 1915] John, a lieutenant, arrived 8 December 1919 on board the *Orcoma*. John was married to **Sybil BENNETT** (*not in the Falkland Islands*). John died 13 February 1956 (*not in the Falkland Islands*). [In Dictionary of Falklands Biography]
6. **William Horace DEAN** born in 1894. William died 27 July 1929 (*not in the Falkland Islands*).
7. **Mabel DEAN** born 22 January 1895. Her father's occupation was recorded as sheep farmer. Mabel, age 6 weeks, died 10 March 1895 from peritonitis and was buried on Pebble Island.
8. **Son DEAN** born 23 May 1898 in London. [FIM Jul 1898]
