FOWLER FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.

Sarah Annie "Annie" FOWLER:

Mr & Mrs BERTRAND, 2 daughters and 2 maids departed Stanley 5 November 1906 on board the Lafonia for Roy Cove (the BERTRAND family had arrived from Liverpool on board the *Oriana* 24 October 1906). A **Miss FOWLER** was working for the BERTRANDs in February 1907.

Mrs, Miss & Roy BERTRAND and **Miss FOWLER** arrived from Roy Cove on board the *Gwendolin* 24 September 1907 and departed Stanley, Falkland Islands 27 September 1907 on board the *Oropesa*.

Miss FOWLER arrived from Hill Cove on board the *Gwendolin* 16 February 1910 and departed Stanley 23 February 1910 on board the *Oropesa*, which was bound for Liverpool, England. Miss A Fowler arrived back in Stanley 18 October 1910 on board the *Orcoma*, which had come from Liverpool, England.

Sarah Annie "Annie" FOWLER was married to George GOODWIN, shepherd, 27 October 1910 at the house of Mr Waddup by J Meredith Bate, Assistant Cathedral Chaplain. The witnesses were Annie Maria Waddup and John F Summers. George's father was recorded as John Goodwin, shepherd and Sarah's father was recorded as Samuel Fowler, market gardener. Annie, age 35, died 1 September 1912 from retained placenta and puerperal septicaemia and was buried at Roy Cove.

FIRST GENERATION:

Children of Annie (1) (3) and George GOODWIN:

1. Elsie Gladys GOODWIN born 5 August 1912 and baptised Elsie Gladys Marjorie GOODWIN 18 February 1913 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as shepherd. Elsie was married to William John DAVIS, farm labourer 4 May 1931 at Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by Fredk S Vaughan, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were James Watson Peck and Agnes Maud Butcher. Elsie's father was recorded as George Goodwin, shepherd and William's father was recorded as Richard Davis, labourer. Elsie, age 78, died 8 June 1991 in Stanley and was buried 12 June 1991 in Grave V3156. William, age 86 and a retired farm worker, died 31 July 1995 in Stanley and was buried 4 August 1995 in Grave V3157.

DESCENDANTS OF SARAH & GEORGE STILL IN THE FALKLAND ISLANDS

Thomas Burt FOWLER:

Thomas Burt FOWLER was born 24 June 1892 at Weston in Gordano, Portishead, England to **Samuel** and **Elizabeth Ann FOWLER**.

Thomas Burt FOWLER, age 18, arrived from West Falkland on board the *Columbus* 6 April 1911 and departed Stanley 19 April 1911 on board the *Orissa*, which was bound for Liverpool, England. Thomas arrived back in Stanley 21 September 1911 on board the *Orcoma*, which had come from Liverpool, England.

Thomas arrived back in Stanley 4 October 1923 (no record of him leaving the Falklands) on board the *Oriana*, which had come from Liverpool, England.

Thomas arrived from Roy Cove on the *Falkland* 16 February 1931. Thomas, age 39, single and a gardener travelled to the UK in 1931 on business. His height was recorded as 5' 6" and his hair and eye colour as brown.



Sarah LEACH:

Miss LEACH arrived in Stanley 20 October 1909 on board the *Oravia*, which had come from Liverpool, England. **Miss LEACH** arrived from West Falkland on board the *Columbus* 4 May 1911 and departed Stanley 17 May 1911 on board the *Esmeraldas*, which was bound for London, England. Thomas was alleged to have fathered Sarah's son who was born in England in 1911.
