

HUTCHINSON FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Any variations which may occur in the spellings of names are recorded as written in the records at the time.

Robert Henry HUTCHINSON was born 8 January 1865 in London, England to **William John HUTCHINSON** and **Mary Ann HUTCHINSON** formerly **CLARK**.

Robert was married to **Elizabeth Ann Charlotte BROWN** 14 October 1883 (*no record of marriage in Falkland Islands*)

Robert drowned in a boating accident 8 October 1890 at Douglas Station. His body was found about 30 November 1890 and buried at Douglas Station 1 December 1890. [Account of accident FIM Oct 1890; FIM Nov 1890]

Elizabeth, widow living at Douglas Station, was married to (2) **John DAVIS**, navy living at Douglas Station, 21 April 1892 at the house of John Davis according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Lars M Berntsen and Ann Elizabeth Davis. Elizabeth's father was recorded as Thomas Brown, soldier, and John's father was recorded as John Davis, sailmaker. Elizabeth had another 10 children with John. Elizabeth, age 91 and a widow, died 10 May 1960 in Stanley and was buried 12 May 1960 in Grave R1666.

Elizabeth Ann Charlotte BROWN was born 1 May 1869 in Capetown.

FIRST GENERATION

Children of Robert and Elizabeth HUTCHINSON:

1. **Mary Anne Elizabeth "Tom" HUTCHINSON** born 7 September 1884 in Stanley and baptised 26 November 1884 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as labourer. Mary was married to **Richard Napoleon BOUND**, manager, 19 September 1916 at Christ Church Cathedral by Banns by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Edwin Henry Bound and Gladys Mildred Davis. Mary's father was recorded as Robert Hutchinson, deceased mariner, and Richard's father was recorded as William Henry Bound, mariner. Richard, age 64, died Thursday 26 March 1942 at his home in Stanley and was buried 29 March 1942 in Grave O1212. [Obituary FI Weekly News 2 April 1942] Mary travelled to Uruguay in 1944 for medical treatment. Mary, age 78, died 24 October 1962 in Stanley and was buried 26 October 1962 in Grave O1725.
2. **Henrietta Jane "Tim" HUTCHINSON** born 12 January 1887 in Stanley and baptised 30 January 1887 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as carter. Henrietta, age 18 and living in Punta Arenas, was married to **Ernest Henry SPENCER**, age 22 and a labourer living in Punta Arenas, 6 June 1904 in the house of Captain Bragg, Punta Arenas according to the rites and ceremonies of the Church of England by Edwin Coupland Aspinall, British Chaplain. The witnesses were Elsie Alberta Bragg and G Bragg. Henrietta's father was recorded as John Hutchinson, labourer, and Ernest's father was recorded as Harry Spencer, sailor. Ernest, age 31 and a corporal in the Falkland Islands Volunteer Corps, drowned while crossing between Engineer Point and the Wireless Telegraph Station 1 December 1914 and was buried 6 December 1914 in Grave I778. Henrietta, age 81 and a widow, died 30 October 1968 in Stanley and was buried 2 November 1968 in Grave T2219.
3. **William John "Bill" HUTCHINSON** born 4 December 1888 at Loch Head, Johnsons Harbour and baptised 4 October 1889 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as carter. William, a carter, was married to **Sybella Mary HALL** 19 April 1916 at Christ Church Cathedral by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were John James Davis and Gladys Mildred Davis. William's father was recorded as Robert Hutchinson, deceased sailor, and Sybella's father was recorded as Lewis James Hall, shepherd. Sybella, age 48, travelled to Montevideo in 1941 for medical reasons. William, age 66 and retired, emigrated to Australia in 1955.
4. **Robert Thomas "Bob" HUTCHINSON** born 30 July 1890 on Douglas Station and baptised 2 October 1891 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as carter. Robert, age 72 and a labourer, died 14 July 1962 in Stanley and was buried 19 July 1962 in Grave S1720.

SECOND GENERATION

Children of Mary (1) and Richard BOUND:

1. **Henry John Lennard BOUND** born 20 December 1917 in Stanley and baptised 27 January 1918 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as farmer. Henry, age 25 and a civil servant, travelled to Montevideo in 1943 for health reasons. Henry, a civil servant, travelled overseas on leave in 1954, 1966 and 1972.
2. **Horace Leslie BOUND** born 7 October 1919 in Stanley and baptised 2 November 1919 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as farmer. Horace, a clerk in the Colonial Treasury, was married to **Joan BIGGS**, clerk in the Colonial Treasury, 3 February 1951 at Christ Church Cathedral by M Floyd Jones BA, Clerk. The witnesses were M J Field and J Bound. Horace's father was recorded as Richard Naoleon Bound, deceased boarding house proprietor, and Joan's father was recorded as Hubert Arthur Biggs, caretaker.

Children of Henrietta (2) and Ernest SPENCER:

1. **Cecilia Winifred SPENCER** born 22 November 1904 in Punta Arenas, Chile and baptised 18 December 1904 by St James Church, Punta Arenas. Cecilia, age 25 and living in Magallanes, was married to **Edward James Campbell PEART**, age 28 and a capitas living on Estancia Springhill, Tierra del Fuego, 23 February 1930 in St James Church, Magallanes according to the law of the country and the rites and ceremonies of the Church of England after civil ceremony by C M Francis, British chaplain. The witnesses were H Hardy and James Hutter. Cecilia's father was recorded as Ernest Henry Spencer, deceased, and Edward's father was recorded as Henry Campbell Peart, excise officer. [Account of wedding Penguin 13 Mar 1930]
2. **William Ernest SPENCER** born 26 March 1907 in Stanley. His father's occupation was recorded as labourer. William, an assistant light keeper, was married to **Elizabeth Agnes GOSS** 26 April 1930 at Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by F S Vaughan, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were William R Hills and Ruth Davis. William's father was recorded as Ernest Henry Spencer, policeman, and Elizabeth's father was recorded as William Henry Goss, cook.

Children of William (3) and Sybella HUTCHINSON:

1. **Edwin James HUTCHINSON** born 2 February 1917 and baptised 11 March 1917 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as carter. Edwin, a haulage contractor, was married to **Fanny Winifred Mary HENRICKSEN** 16 November 1946 at the Registrar's Office, Stanley by H Bennett, Ag Registrar General. The witnesses were K R Henricksen and E Henricksen. Edwin's father was recorded as William John Hutchinson, general merchant, and Fanny's father was recorded as Frederick Henricksen, deceased shepherd. Edwin, a haulage contractor, and Fanny departed 18 November 1946 on board the ss *Fitzroy* travelling to Australia via Buenos Aires.
2. **Keith Ronald HUTCHINSON** [REDACTED] His father's occupation was recorded as carter. Keith, a butcher living in Stanley, was married to **Rica WATSON**, also living in Stanley, 27 September 1943
