### KING FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Any variations which may occur in the spellings of names are recorded as written in the records at the time.

Frederick KING was born circa 1824 (not in Falkland Islands).

Frederick KING was married to Jane ISBEL (not in Falkland Islands).

**Frederick KING**, his wife **Jane KING** and their two children **Frederick Isbell KING** and **Ellen Sophia KING** arrived in the Falkland Islands 28 September 1852 on board the barque *Record* which left from Liverpool. Frederick, who was recorded as a cooper and carpenter, was brought out by the Falkland Islands Company Limited as part of a group of shepherds and artisans. [D6, pg152, H11]

In May 1870 Frederick was renting a house belonging to Isaac Smith and the soil from his privy was coming out onto the street. [D14, pg29] Frederick purchased the house 15 July 1886 for £250. [Land Reg Vol II] - Crown grant 52.

**Frederick KING** died 12 July 1892 from gout in the stomach, age 68, and was buried 17 July 1892 in Grave D290.

Jane KING died 5 September 1910 from cerebral haemorrhage and heart failure, age 84, and was buried 8 September 1910 in Grave I727. [Obituary CM Oct 1910]

## FIRST GENERATION:

#### Children of Frederick and Jane KING:

- 1. Frederick Isbell KING born (not in Falkland Islands). Frederick, a storekeeper living in Stanley, was married to Emily KISELEY, widow, 15 November 1875 in the Parish Church according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Henry C Lory Act Col Chaplain. The witnesses were T Sharp and Mary Ann Luxton. Emily's father was recorded as Thomas Darrington, labourer. Both Frederick and Emily were recorded as being of full age (21 or older). Frederick and Emily moved to England in on his retirement. They left Stanley 17 May 1910 on board the Orissa bound for Liverpool. Frederick died 9 December 1912 in Bedford, England. [Death notice CM Feb 1913] Emily died 16 September 1932 at the residence of her nephew, J King senior, 61 Denmark Street, Bedford, England. [Obituary CM Dec 1932]
- 2. Ellen Sophia KING born circa 1852 in England. Ellen, age 19, was married to Francis Joseph "Joseph" LELLMAN, carpenter from Germany, 1 June 1871 at Trinity Church Stanley according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Church of England by Banns by Charles Bull MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Frederick King, F I King Jnr, Caroline Matilda Dawson, Alice King and Isabella King. Francis' father was recorded as Francis Matthias Lellman, teacher. Joseph died 31 December 1897 and was buried in Grave D291 (age and cause of death not recorded in burial or death registers). According to his death notice he was 51. [CM Dec 1897] Ellen died 29 September 1910 from cancer and was buried 2 October 1910 in Grave I728.
- 3. George Thomas KING born 1 September 1853 in Stanley and baptised 2 October 1853 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. George was married to Elizabeth CULL (not in Falkland Islands). George owned 47 Fitzroy Road, Stanley. George, a foreman carpenter, died 17 December 1919 and was buried 19 December 1919 in Grave D844. Elizabeth died 15 August 1937, age 74, and was buried 18 August 1937 in Grave D1111.
- 4. **Mary KING** born circa September 1854 (not in birth register). Mary died circa May 1855 in Stanley (not in death register), age 8 months, and was buried 1 June 1855 (no Grave record).
- 5. **James Alfred KING** born 8 February 1856 in Stanley and baptised 6 April 1856 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. James died 22 June 1857 in Stanley from convulsions and was buried 26 June 1857 (no grave record).
- 6. Alice KING born 28 February 1858 in Stanley and baptised 2 May 1858 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Alice was married to William James BIGGS, carpenter living in Stanley, 8 May 1878 in the Parish Church according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Emilie King and George Thomas King. William's father was recorded as William Biggs, carpenter. William, a carpenter, died 1 June 1921, age 68, and was buried 5 June in Grave li850. Alice died 28 January 1925 and was buried 30 January 1925 in Grave L914.

- 7. **Emily Muraus KING** born April 1860 (not entered in birth register) and baptised 17 July 1860 by Holy Trinity Church. Emily died 9 October 1878 in Stanley, age 18 years and 6 months, from paralysis and was buried 13 October 1878 in Grave E449.
- 8. **Isabella Jane KING** born 6 January 1862 in Stanley and baptised 16 March 1862 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Isabella was married to **George Henry CROOK**, artist living in Stanley, 13 April 1879 in the Parish Church according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church after Banns by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Frederick King and Elizabeth Melville. George's father was recorded as James Crook, commission merchant.
- 9. **Mary KING** born 16 November 1863 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Mary died 16 November 1863 from convulsions, age 6 hours *(no burial or Grave records).*
- 10. Alfred KING born 13 December 1865 in Stanley and baptised 11 March 1866 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Alfred, an overseer at Douglas Station, was married to Alice Marion (Mary Ann) ALDRIDGE 22 February 1906 at Christ Church Cathedral, Stanley by Lowther E Brandon MA Dean & Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Victor Lellman and Annie L Benney. Alice's father was recorded as Thomas Aldridge, publican. Alfred died 26 June 1921 from irregular gout gouty diathesis and pyogenic meningitis and was buried 29 June 1921 in Grave 1863. Alice died 23 July 1960 in Stanley, age 93, and was buried 28 July 1960 in Grave L1674.
- 11. Lily Geraldine KING born 12 March 1870 in Stanley and baptised 8 May 1870 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Lily, a schoolmistress, was married to Edwin James RUTTER, mariner, 5 April 1894 in the Parish Church according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church after Banns by Lowther E Brandon MA Dean & Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Fred I King and Martin Johnson. Edwin's father was recorded as William Rutter, foreman.

## **SECOND GENERATION:**

## Children of Ellen (2) and Francis LELLMAN:

- Madeline Jane LELLMAN born 27 December 1873 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Madeline was married to Herbert Henry HILL, minister of Christ, 5 January 1897 in the Baptist Tabernacle according to the Rites & Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Edwin Coupland Aspinall Canon of Christ Church. The witnesses were J G Wickham Bertrand and Frederica Josephine Lellman. Herbert's father was recorded as Rowland Hill, wagon inspector.
- 2. Frederica Josephine LELLMAN born 18 February 1876 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Frederica was married to William Austen THOMPSON, colonial treasurer, 3 August 1902 in the Parish of Christ Church according to the Rites & Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Dean & Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Franz F Lellman and Cyssie Lellman. William's father was recorded as Alexander James Thompson, provost master, Bahamas, West Indies.
- 3. Francis/Franz Frederick/Fritz LELLMAN born 13 May 1878 in Stanley. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Franz, a painter, was married to Margaret BINNIE 11 October 1908 in Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by C Rome Hall, Assistant Cathedral Chaplain. The witnesses were Edward Beveridge Binnie, Victor Joseph Lellman and Sarah McGill. Margaret's father was recorded as William Binnie, tailor. Margaret died 15 November 1951, age 72, and is buried in Grave 1469. Francis died 15 September 1955.
- 4. Albert Ferdinand LELLMAN born 9 March 1881 in Stanley. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Albert, a carpenter, was married to Frances ROWLANDS 27 February 1907 at Christ Church Cathedral, Stanley by C Rome Hall, BA, Assistant Chaplain. The witnesses were Franz F Lellman and F Rowlands. Frances' father was recorded as Francis Rowlands, master mariner. In 1913 Albert was awarded £66 by the FIC Ltd on account of an injury to his eye while at work. [FIC/D12; pg 529] Albert, a carpenter, died 13 July 1973 in Stanley. Frances died 22 November 1933, age 51, from coma and diabetes mellitus.
- 5. Anna Emilie LELLMAN born 18 January 1883 in Stanley. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Anna was married to Francis Ernest BURROWES, electricial engineer 16 October 1912 at Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by Edward J Seymour, Dean & Chaplain. The witnesses were Victor Joseph Lellman, Orissa Lewis-Dean and Franz F Lellman. Francis' father was recorded as George Burrowes, deceased cabinet maker.
- 6. Victor Joseph LELLMAN born 1 August 1884. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Victor, commercially employed, was married to Isabella Frazer WATSON 11 March 1914 at Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by C McDonald Hobley. Assistant Chaplain. The witnesses were Mary Fleuret, Violet E Lellman, Franz F Lellman and D Russel Watson. Isabella's father was recorded as Thomas Watson, commercial. Victor, a civil servant, died 26 February 1941 from cerebral thrombosis and multiple thrombosis of veins. Isabella died 4 April 1942, age 55, from chronic inanition.

- 7. **Owen August LELLMAN** (twin) born 13 April 1889 in Stanley and baptised 1 June 1889 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Owen died 1 October 1890 from bronchitis and was buried 5 October 1890 in Grave D292.
- 8. **Violet Ellen LELLMAN** (twin) born 13 April 1889 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter

# Children of George (3) and Elizabeth KING:

- Frederick Henry KING born 30 December 1885 at Port Stephens and baptised 13 June 1886 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Frederick, a carpenter, was married to Ella Malvina BIGGS 15 Mar 1911 in Christ Church Cathedral after Banns by Edward J Seymour, Chaplain & Hon Canon. The witnesses were Elsie Malvina Kelway and Alfred King. Ella's father was recorded as Edward Falkland Biggs, deceased.
- 2. Alfred Bertram KING born 22 November 1888 in Stanley and baptised 24 March 1889 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Alfred, a carpenter, was married to **Mabel Annie SARNEY** 5 July 1916 at Christ Church Cathedral by Banns by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Joseph Lehen and Ellen May Ethel King. Mabel's father was recorded as Harry Sarney, cook. Alfred, a caretaker, died 25 July 1946 from acute heart failure and arteriosclerosis and was buried 28 July 196 in Grave P1325.
  - Mabel, a widow, was married to **John Samuel BARNES**, widower and contractor, 25 February 1950 at Christ Church Cathedral by R G R Calvert MA, Senior Chaplain. The witnesses were Gordon Arthur Howkins and Olga Annie Howkins. John's father was recorded as Arthur James Barnes, deceased.
- 3. **Owen Isbell KING** born 16 April 1890 and baptised 8 March 1891. Owen, a carpenter, was married to (1) **Louisa Margaret SMITH** 25 February 1914 at Christ Church Cathedral by Banns by C McDonald Hobley. Chaplain. The witnesses were H E Bennett, Lilian Cara King, A B King, and Lucy Smith. Louisa's father was recorded as Edwin John Smith, shepherd. Louisa died 1 October 1915, age 24, from shock and heart failure and was buried 3 October 1915 in Grave F800.
  - Owen, a widower and carpenter, was married to (2) **Jane Isbell BIGGS** (see (6) (7)) 7 July 1934 at Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by Harold E Lumsdale, Dean of Christ Church. The witnesses were B E Robson and B C Biggs. Jane's father was recorded as William Biggs, carpenter.
- 4. **Cecil Francis KING** born 19 June 1892 in Stanley and baptised 16 April 1893 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Cecil, a retired farm worker, died 30 August 1974 in Stanley and was buried 2 September 1974 in Grave U1834.
- 5. **Evalina Jane KING** born 23 March 1894 and baptised 20 April 1894 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Evelina died 29 September 1895 in Stanley from gastric fever and was buried 3 October 1895 in Grave A181.
- 6. **Lillian Clara KING** born 29 March 1896 and baptised 10 May 1896 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Lilian was married to **David Chapman STACEY**, mechanic, 8 September 1923 at Christ Church Cathedral by J Stanley

Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were R L Robson and Violet M King. David's father was recorded as David Chapman Stacey, deceased storekeeper. David, a caretaker from England, died 12 October 1964, age 76, and was buried 15 October 1964 in Grave T2018. Lilian died 1 March 1987 and was buried in Grave T2017.

- 7. Ellen May Ethel "Nellie" KING born 29 April 1898 and baptised 10 July 1898 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Nellie joined the staf at the Cathedral Press in 1914. [CM Oct 1914] Ellen was married to John ROSS, mason, 25 August 1926 at Christ Church Cathedral by Banns by Fredk T Vaughan, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were William Wilson and Gwendoline Isabella King. John's father was recorded as John Ross, farmer. Ellen and John emigrated to Scotland in 1928.
- 8. **Alice Elizabeth KING** born 29 March 1900 and baptised 10 June 1900 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Alice died 12 November 1901 from capilliary bronchitis and was buried 17 November 1901 in Grave Ai182.
- 9. Violet Malvina Emily KING born 12 December 1901. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Violet was married to Robert Lionel ROBSON 27 December 1928 at St Mary's Roman Catholic Chapel, Stanley by Special Licence by Mario Louis Migone, Priest in Charge. The witnesses were George John Robson and Gwendolin Isabella King. Robert died 16 August 1976 and is buried in Grave R1877. Violet died 28 March 1987 and is buried in Grave V3074.
- 10. Gwendoline Isabella KING born 8 March 1904 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Gwendoline was married to John Frederick Charles JONES, mariner, 3 August 1929 at Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by S E E Aylward, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Owen Isbell King and Violet Malvina Emilie Robson. John's father was recorded as John William Jones, mariner. Gwendoline died 1 April 1942 from pulmonary tuberculosis and multiple pregnancies and is buried in Grave O1213. John's body was found in the Government School Stokehold 14 November 1960 and he is buried in Grave S1683.

## Children of Alice (6) and William BIGGS:

- 1. Emily Maude BIGGS born 20 March 1880 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Emily, who was living in Darwin, was married to Donald MORRISON, age 29 and a horse tamer living at Egg Harbour, 9 May 1902 in the Church, Darwin according to the Rites & Ceremonies of the Established Church by Lowther E Brandon MA Dean & Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were John Morrison and William James Biggs. Donald's father was recorded as Ewlain Morrison, shepherd. Donald died 27 August 1931, age 58, and was buried 30 August 1931 in Grave K1025. Emily died 23 June 1959 in Stanley and was buried 26 June 1959 in Grave S1635.
- 2. **Herbert Reginald BIGGS** born 29 September 1883. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Herbert died 29 June 1884 in Stanley from convulsions and was buried 4 July 1884 in Grave Ei391.
- Bernard Claud BIGGS born 20 June 1885 in Stanley. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Bernard was married to Kathleen Mary BIGGS 15 September 1914 at St Mary's Roman Catholic Chapel, Stanley by Mario Louis Migone. The witnesses were

Mabel N Biggs and W J McAtasney. Kathleen's father was recorded as George P Biggs, carpenter.

- William Frederick BIGGS born 23 April 1888 in Stanley. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter/shipwright. William died 12 December 1906 at Darwin from a compound fracture of the skull.
- 5. **Hubert Arthur BIGGS** born 1 July 1890 in Stanley. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Hubert, a labourer, was married to **Isabella MIDDLETON** 18 October 1924 at Darwin, East Falkland by Governor's Licence by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Peter Coutts and Frances Mary Middleton. Isabella's father was recorded as Lindsay Middleton, shepherd. Isabella died 12 March 1955 in Stanley, age 50, and was buried 16 March 1955 in Grave Q1752. Hubert, a retired caretaker, died 9 June 1964 in Stanley and was buried 11 June 1964 in Grave Q1752.
- 6. Alice Madeline BIGGS born 19 April 1894 at Darwin harbour. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Alice was married to Robert Henry HANNAFORD, carpenter, 19 October 1915 at Christ Church Cathedral by C McDonald Hobley, Chaplain. The witnesses were Bernard C Biggs and Jane Isbell Biggs. Robert's father was recorded as Henry Hannaford, farmer. Robert, a foreman carpenter from England, died 25 September 1953, age 66, and was buried 28 September 1953 in Grave Q1519. Alice, a telephone operator, emigrated to New Zealand in 1962. Her ashes were buried in Grave Q1749 (no date recorded).
- 7. **Jane Isbell BIGGS** born 24 August 1896 at Darwin. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Jane was married to **Owen Isbell KING** (see (3) (3)), widower and carpenter, 7 July 1934 at Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by Harold E Lumsdale, Dean of Christ Church. The witnesses were B E Robson and B C Biggs. Owen's father was recorded as George Thomas King, carpenter.
- 8. **Alfred Stanley BIGGS** born 29 May 1899 at Darwin. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Alfred, a carpenter, was married to **Pearle Gladys OLSSEN**, widow, 20 February 1924 in the Registrar General's Office, Stanley by Edw B Binnie, Ag Registrar. The witnesses were V Atkins and Gwendoline Hardy. Pearle's father was recorded as William Richard Hardy, deceased.

## Children of Isabella (8) and George CROOK:

- 1. **Ethel Isabel CROOK** born 3 March 1880 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as publican.
- 2. **Frederick James CROOK** born 16 July 1882 in Stanley. His father's occupation was recorded as hotel keeper.

## Children of Lily (11) and Edwin RUTTER:

1. **Isabel Bessie RUTTER** born 5 February 1895. Her father's occupation was recorded as bartender.
