McKINNON FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.

John McKINNON, age 32, and his wife **Anne McKINNON**, age 26, departed London on board the *Matilda* on 17 November 1866, arriving in Stanley 22 January 1867. [H22; D12, pg 378] John started working for the Falkland Islands Company Limited in the Lafonia area in January 1867 on a monthly wage of £3-10-0. In October 1870 John and his wife were living at Bluff Creek. In January 1872 John was receiving a monthly wage of £4-3-4 and received a cash order for the balance of his FIC account of £5-18-7. By 1894 John was working for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd again and was on a monthly wage of £6-0-0. He finished working for them 9 May 1894 and John and his wife arrived in Stanley from Darwin on board the *Hadassah* 11 May 1894 [FIC Archives; FIM May 1894]
