I understand that the same applies to horses arriving from Bahia Blanca as from Punta Arenas as both the Consul at Buenos Ayres and at Punta Arenas state that there is no foot and mouth disease in either place, and subject to inspection, there is no reason why the horses should not be landed without quarantine. I understand that the horses will not be coming on the first trip and it is intended to import two or three at the most. If necessary these could be quarantined in Mr Felton's paddock as I understand that he will be importing them.

Extract from Minutes of Meeting of Executive Council held on
the 20th January, 1923

"Council decided that the horses imported from Punta Arenas should undergo a disinfectant footbath on landing and be kept under observation in the Naval Wireless Paddock for one week, provided the permission of the Officer-in-Charge was obtained." The horses imported from Bahía Blanca should undergo similar treatment at the port of landing.
