Sir,

We hereby give notice that we propose to import into the Falkland Islands the following animals

One Jersey Bull (breed PPC)

Three Jersey Cows

Twelve horses, of either sex.

They are to be purchased in the district of Bahia Blanca, Argentine Republic, and to be shipped from the Port of Bahia Blanca.

The animals on arrival are to be landed direct at Port Stanley, or wherever the stock Inspector may indicate.

Date of arrival will depend on shipping facilities which are uncertain for the moment.

The animals are to be consigned to the order of Estate Louis Williams.

We shall announce the approximate date of arrival once our negotiations for the purchase and shipment of these animals are more advanced. In the meantime we beg to make this provisional announcement in order to comply with the two month's notice required according to "The Live Stock Regulations (Consolidation) 1925"
