Sir,

There is an order in force prohibiting the export of Sheep from the Falkland Islands and as there are no freezing works on the Islands, the only outlet for stock is canning. A Chilian Company, "Compania Frigorifico de la Patagonia" having works in the Straits of Magellan are prepared to buy wethers and ewes, giving a guarantee that same will be dealt with and shipped to this country and a further guarantee would be given by Messrs. Weddell and Company, of London through whom the Compania Frigorifico de La Patagonia's produce is sold. Under these circumstances it would be to the advantage of this country as well as the farmers for permits to be given allowing shipments to be made by the Freezing Company and as owners of a large property in the West Falklands, we would ask you to kindly consider the matter and let us know if this could be arranged. The business is of some urgency as arrangements for sale of the coming season's stock should be made shortly.
