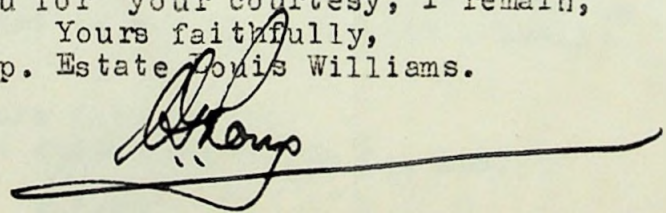
Dear Mr. Cooper,

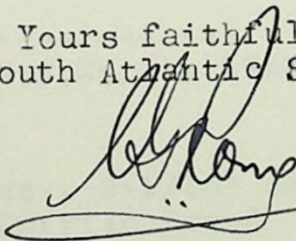
