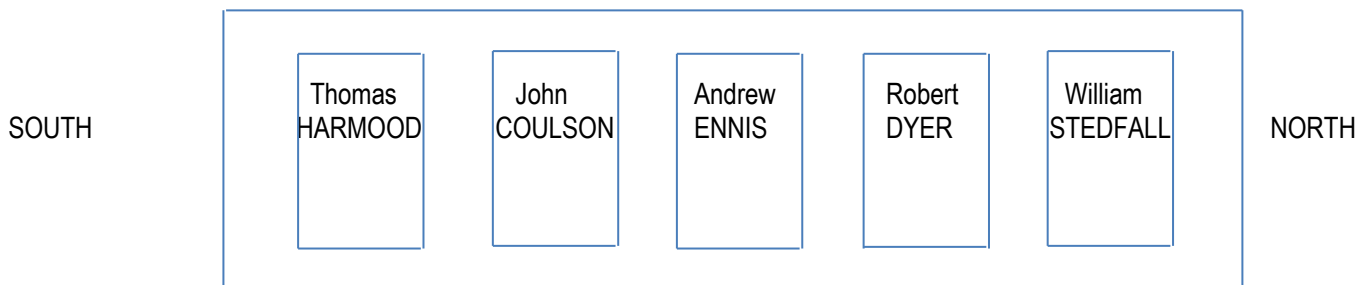


# Port Egmont Military Cemetery

NAME	DATE OF DEATH	AGE	NOTES
HARMOOD, Thomas	1766 Jul 20		From HMS <i>Jason</i> . Died at 6am Sunday. Laid to rest with 3 vols small arms Monday 21 July 1766
COULSON, John	1766 Nov 29		From HMS <i>Jason</i> . Died at 4pm Saturday. Buried with 3 vols small arms at 7pm Sunday 30 November 1766
ENNIS, Andrew	1766 Dec 26		Master-at-arms HMS <i>Jason</i> . Died on Friday 26 December 1766
DYER, Robert	1769 Apr 15		Purser HMS <i>Favourite</i>
STEDFALL, William	1769 or 1770		Private RMLI. Either HMS <i>Favourite</i> or <i>Swift</i>



## Port Egmont

Near the summit of the hill on which the old settlement stood:

NAME	DATE OF DEATH	AGE	NOTES
MOTT, Samuel	1831 Dec 11		According to W Parker Snow in 1855 the inscription read: In Memory of Samuel Mott Who died on board the sch: <i>Hope</i> of New York, Decr 11 <sup>th</sup> , 1831. Stranger, whene'er you cross this heath, Tread lightly, for you tread on death: Pause and reflect, for you, as well as I, Must pay the debt of nature: you must die.

On the edge of the cliffs:

NAME	DATE OF DEATH	AGE	NOTES
UNKNOWN			According to W Parker Snow in 1855 the inscription on the stone had been obliterated by the weather

## Saunders Island Settlement Cemetery

Consecrated 22 April 1930:

PITALUGA, Rose Harriet	1910 Feb 03	9 ½	Daughter of James & Ellen. Died on Saunders Island. Congenital hypothyroidism
RUMBOLDS, Mary Ellen "May"	1922 Apr 19	25	1 <sup>st</sup> wife of William. Daughter of George & Mary JOHNSON. Died on Saunders Island. TB
DAVIS, Dawn Ellen	1938 Nov 26	5 mths	Daughter of Stanley & Ellen. Died on Saunders Island. Pneumonia
McGHIE, Moira	1994 Mar 11	54	Wife of Tom. Died in England
POLE-EVANS, Anthony Reginald	2010 Jul 15	90	Son of Reginald & Orissa. Husband of Jessie
