McRAE, Cyril Duncan	1931 Dec 07	13 days	Son of Roderick & Clara. Marasmus
McRAE, Evelyn Fannie	1931 Dec 08	14 days	Daughter of Roderick & Clara. Marasmus
MORRISON, Eric	1932 Feb 17	13 days	Son of Donald & Mary. Acute infantile diarrhoea & marasmus



In a clay patch between the settlement & the beach opposite Veronica Point:

BOWES, William "Billy"	1909 Dec 31	Abt 34	Cut his own throat whilst of unsound mind

Above the beach opposite Veronica Point, Fox Island:

NAME	DATE OF DEATH	AGE	NOTES
RATTLEY, George Alexander	1928 Jan 04	73	British cook. Widower of Mary. Found dead at Edye Creek. Wooden cross
WESSEL, Carl Christian "Eddie"	1928 Apr 01	71	Born 11 April 1858 in Hamburg. Arrived circa 1891. On 16 September 1916 he was recorded as owning a shepherds hut and 629 sheep on Passage Island and adjacent small islands, which he leased from the Government. Found dead at Spring Point 1 April 1928. Headstone

On Veronica Point, Fox Island:

NAME	DATE OF DEATH	AGE	NOTES
HOODLESS, Thomas, Captain	1889 May 14	56	Native of Aberdeen, Scotland. Had been visiting the Falklands as a captain from at least 1867. Died at Spring Point from a cerebral apoplexy. Was a supercargo of ss <i>Grandholm</i> .
