Most of our readers are aware that a Settler, named Rendle, perished some years ago between Teal Inlet and Douglas Station. His saddle, gear and melitas were only found a short time ago by Lee Whitman, to the East of Sierra Chata House, about 50 yards to the North of the track. Rendle had evidently taken them off the horse and put them into a hole, covering them with diddle-dee. The ground was very swampy, and the saddle was broken, the horse had evidently been bogged, getting out how ever after Rendle had left it.
