These additional notice boards to make Dean Street (from Ross Road to John Street only) a 'one-way' road will be fixed as ordered, but I am of the opinion that one-may roads such as this will tend to negligence on the part of motorists and cyclists. As it is now the majority of drivers and cyclists () cluding children) know that there are blind corners and they take the necessary precautions, but I am afraid that less inconstreet is for one way traffic only they will not utilise caution (e.g turning the out corner on to the main road at speed). One way streets in England are infrequent and are usually a back street and . not part of blocks such as this one, and I understand that they are not a success in England.

2. I would suggest that a system of education in "Road Sense", by articles in the 'Penguin" and talks in the school, rather than restrictive policy is preferable. I attach booklet on Road Sense which contains useful

information in this direction, although it does not refer to cyclists. If this was done the Police could then stop and inform (or caution if necessary) drivers, cyclists or pedestrians of their mistakes.

- 3. The notice 'NO EXIT' as suggested in the Acting Magistrate's minute of 29th May, 1934 will be erected at the bungalow corner facing South or South West.
- 4. An improvement for public safety would be the removal of the high West boundary iron fence to Stanley Cottage on the junction of Hoss Road-Villiers Street, and replacement with a lower or batten fence, or the tapering off of the existing fence towards Ross Road. This property belongs to Mr. W.H.Luxton of Chartres.



DRAFT NOTICE.

leading past

The roadway from the Colonial Secretary's offices from Ross Road has been extended westwards to meet Reservoir Road, and, for the safety of the public and on account of the dangerous corner at Mrs Lee. Felton's bungalow, the Government has decided to make the roads in this section for ONE-WAY traffic only.

Traffic will enter at the junction of Ross Road and Mrs A.E.Felton's bungalow corner and will emerge on to the main roads at

- (a). St Mary's Walk. near Mr. S. Aldridge's house.
- (b). Reservoir Road. the termination of the new road formed passing Mr. A.Steel's house.
- (c). Reservoir Road. the termination of the road passing through the Hospital grounds,

according to the places required to be visited.

<u>Exit</u> on to Ross Road near Mrs A.E.Felton's bungalow is prohibited, and similarly <u>entry</u> from St. Mary's Walk and the two roads terminating at Reservoir Road is prohibited.

Traffic notices have been fixed at :-

- The bungalow corner, Ross Road reading "IN ONLY" and facing South another one reading "NO EXIT".
- Reservoir Road junction of new road, reading "'OUT" facing East.
 "'NO ROAD" facing West.
- Reservoir road junction of road passing through the Hospital grounds, reading "OUT" facing East.
 "NO ROAD" facing West.
- St. Mary's Walk near Mr. S.Aldridge's house reading "OUT. CAUTION" facing North.
 "NO ROAD" facing South.
