Sir,

I beg to refer to Government Notice No. 28 of 1925 giving a list of public holidays during the current year.

2. At the last meeting of the Stanley Sports Association it was the general opinion of the members that, so far as the customary Christmas Sports and entertainments are concerned, it will be very difficult - if not impossible - to arrange a suitable programme for the dates given - namely the 24th, 25th and 26th December.
