15 Minute Hamlet by Tom Stoppard (to be directed by Jason Lewis)

All is not well in the country of Denmark, the ghost of the Old King tells his son, Hamlet, that he was murdered by Claudius, Hamlet's Uncle. Hamlet tries to get his revenge but for his troubles he is sent to London to be killed! Somehow he escapes and returns to Denmark, then, almost everyone dies! A classic Shakespeare play which normally lasts over 2 hours, with a cast of over 20. HOWEVER, we are going to condense this to about 15 minutes with a reduced cast of 5! There will be a few quick changes and a few lines missing but all the major factors will still be in the play, including:

- The famous line "Alas Poor Yorick"
- The fight scene at the end
- · And the appearance of Shakespeare

This version of Hamlet is designed to be a comedy and FIODA are looking for 5 adult male or female actors who are definitely prepared to have fun!
