I wish to bring to your notice the dirty and unserviceable condition in which No. 224 Private D. Williams returned his rifle to the Armoury on Friday 16th May 1930.

The rifle was covered with dust, and the barrel was so rusty that it is absolutely unserviceable and unfit for further use.

He was issued with his rifle on 25th October 1929 and fired his Class Firing on 27th October 1929., the rifle was then in good condition, and he obtained the score of 71, First Class shot.

I asked for an explaination as to how he let the rifle get into such an unserviceable condition and he could not give one, except that he oiled it after firing.

I told him I would have to report the matter to his commanding Officer.
