At some time the door has been over swung, so having sprung the door frame (of iron) consequently the heavy door cannot be properly shut without considerable force, and if shut cannot be again opened without using a pinch bar. To effect the necessary repairs Subsequent Paper. it will require that the door be taken down and the frame removed. The frame will have to go to

to the smithy and probably the door. This will take atnleast a week and the estimated cost for material and labour is  $\pounds 20$ .

2. Should approval be given for this work to be put in hand I should be glad to know to what Head and Sub-Head the expenditure is to be charged.


