GOVERNMENT NOTICE

Colonial Secretary's Office,
Stanley, Falkland Islands.
30th June, 1919.

The Governor directs it to be notified for general information that His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for the Colonies has informed him that in the United Kingdom it is proposed that Peace Celebrations should be held on Saturday the 2nd August, Monday the 4th and Tuesday the 5th August, 1919, and that Sunday the 3rd August shall be observed as the day on which special Religious Services should be held.

As it is possible these days will also be observed in like manner through^{out} the British Empire, the People of the Falkland Islands would no doubt wish in this matter to act in harmony with other parts of the Empire. The Governor therefore directs it to be notified that Saturday the 2nd August, Monday the 4th, and Tuesday the 5th August, 1919, will be observed as Public Holidays in the Falkland Islands, when the Government Offices will be closed accordingly; and that Sunday the 3rd August will be observed as the day on which special Peace Services should be held in this Colony.
