Cypher telegram received from Admiralty at 10 p.m. 19th May, 1915.

Telegraph Admiralty Welsh coal also stock and description
of lubricating oil at Falkland Islands.

21st May. In reply to your telegram of the 10th May, 4900 tons coal on board Manchester Civilian here since the 10th April waiting further orders. In Naval Store Depot, olive oil gallons 11800, mineral oil 8400, mineral oil heavy 100.
