Circular No. 17. Secret. I should be glad to have your wishes as to desirability in the event of war of allowing wives and families of officials to join their husbands in territory under your administration if shipping accommodation is available. If you favour strongly recommending restrictions would you briefly indicate their nature.

This enquiry only relates to the opening period of war say first 6 months.

Any policy now decided on may have to be modified later in the light of developments.
