Any enemy action involving employment of (from Troopers to Commands concerned repeated to Malta Aden Colombo Mauritius Seychelles No. 90644 anti-aircraft & 24th May) Coast Artillery guns or C.A.S.Lo's to be reported immediately by cable to the War Office A.A.4 giving main features of attack and results. This cabled information to be followed as soon as possible by a detailed report by letter despatched by quickest means.
