King Edward Cove, South Georgia

9th March, 1915.

Sir,

I have the honour to report for the information of His Excellency the Governor, the visit to King Edward Cove of the Corvette "URUGUAY" of Buenos Aires on the 28th February last.

2. The "URUGUAY" had been to South Orkney Islands landing Meteorological Observers with provisions etc for the year, calling at South Georgia on the return voyage and leaving again on the 2nd March; a mail was brought from the Whaling Factory operating at South Orkneys and posted from here.

3. During the short stay at this port the Commandante paid an Official visit to the Government Quarters.
