

Sir,

I have the honour to state, for your information, that the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty have approved the adoption of the following names in Admiralty publications:-
SCOTIA SEA bounded by a line drawn from Burdwood Bank in 55° W. through the Shag Rocks, South Georgia, South Sandwich Islands, South Orkneys, the position 66° S. lat., 55° W. long., and from there along the meridian of 55° W. to the Burdwood Bank.

DRAKE PASSAGE bounded on the north by the latitude of Cape Horn, on the east by the meridian of 55° W. long., and on the south by the South Shetland Islands.

WEDDELL SEA is bounded by a line joining the north-eastern extremity of Coats Land to Joinville Island.
