As we have not yet received the annual license for whaling in the territorial waters of South Shetland and Graham's Land and for a third whaler, we have today taken the liberty to send the license fee for the floating factory s/s "SVEND FOYN I" and the whalers "GRAHAM", "SCOTT" and "SELVIK", to the Crown Agents for the Colonies in a bank draft on London for £300.0.0 and we shall feel obliged if you will in return for same send us the licenses for the season 1915-1916.

The steamer "SVEND FOYN I" is now discharged and the entire cargo has been delivered to Messrs De-No-Fa, Fredrikstad, on account of Messrs Lever Brothers, Liverpool.
