

Gentlemen,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th of December, enclosing a cheque for £400 and applying on behalf of the Norge Whaling Co. for a renewal of their licence in respect of the South Shetlands and Grahams Land for the season 1919-20.

2. We are authorized by the Secretary of State for the Colonies to accept from you the £200 tendered in respect of the floating factory and the £100 in respect of a third catcher, but to return to you the remaining £100 and to remind you that the licence issued to the Norge Co. for a fourth catcher was strictly temporary for 1918-19 and cannot be renewed for the season 1919-20.

3. We have accordingly now cashed your cheque for £400, and send you herewith a form of receipt to enable you to obtain repayment of the sum of £100 last referred to above.

4. We are reporting the matter to the Government of the Falkland Islands.

Gentlemen,

I am directed by the Governor to inform you that in accordance with the request contained in your letter to the Crown Agents for the Colonies, dated the 4th December, 1918, I have forwarded to the Crown Agents the following licences entitling the Norge Whaling Company to operate in the waters of the South Shetlands and Graham's Land during the 1919-1920 season :-

- Licence No 103 for the s.s. "Solstreif" (factory)
 "Eik"
 "Ek"
- Licence No 31 for the s.s. "Bjerk".

These licences are issued on the condition that all whale oil shall be exported to, and for delivery and sale in, the United Kingdom, unless otherwise authorized by special licence from the Secretary of State for the Colonies.
