With reference to your telegraphic communication of the 14th ultimo, on the subject of the S/S "Odd.l."investigati: conditions of pelagic whaling, I beg to inform you that on the return of the Catcher to South Georgia nothing could be gained by questioning the Master (who is also the Captain of the S/S "Thoroy"), but enquiries made in other directions have resulted in the following information, which can be taken as correct:-

The "Odd.l." went to Southward of Shetlands and Grahams
Land to find if there was any possibility of anchoring a
Factory at Peter Island which lies in 69 S. and 90 W, more or
less and which is looked upon as outside British jurisdiction.

The Island was reached but no landing made nor harbour found but the bottom was sounded.

From general rumour it appears that this Company do not hold out any hope of their lease of land being renewed in South Georgia and are looking ahead with intentions of floating a pelagic factory.
