REPORT ON THE WHALING INDUSTRY AT SOUTH GEORGIA DURING THE PERIOD FROM 1st JULY to 30th SEPTEMBER, 1916. (Interim)

During the quarter under review, only three of the whaling companies operated, namely: South Georgia Co. Ltd., Compania Argentin de Pesca and the Tonsberg Whaling Co. During this period 267 whales were taken from which 12883 barrels of oil were produced, making an average of about 48 barrels to each whale; out of the whole of the year this is the period when least is done, owing chiefly to the continued stormy nature of the weather, the whales also at this time are very shy and only the very fast whale catchers have any chance of catching them. During the same period last year 276 whales were taken, shewing an increase of 129 whales.

The amount of oil avaiting shipment on the 30th Sept. dsestimated at 66966 made up as follows:
