AN ORDANANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT BY
NON-BRITISH WHALING COMPANIES OF AN ADDITIONAL
EXPORT DUTY ON WHALE OIL

Preamble

Whereas, owing to special expenditure connected with the War, it has been found necessary to impose a provisional war tax in this Colony;

Enacting Clause

Be it enacted by the Governor &c.,

Short Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as The War Expenditure Taxation Ordinance, 1917.

Additional export duty of 42d. per barrel to be paid on whale oil exported

2. In addition to the export duty of \*\*\* Threepence-half-penny per barrel of whale oil gayable under the provisions of The Tariff (Export Buty) Amendment Ordinance, 1915, a special export duty of Fourpence-Half-penny per barrel of Forty gallons of whale oil shall be paid in respect of all whale oil exported from the Colony or from its any of its Dependencies.

British companies to be expanted

3. Any whaling company holding a licence to take whales in Colonial waters or a lease of Crown Land granted for the purpose of enabling such company to carry on whaling operations in Colonial waters, which shall show to the satisfaction of the Governor that it as a recognised British company paying war taxation into the Imperial Treasury shall be exempt from all payment of the additional tax herein provided for.

Duration of Ordinance

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st
January, 1918, and shall remain in force until the
31st December of the year wherein the present war

shall end.

Ordinance to be in force in Dependencies 5. This Ordinance shall be in force in the Dependencies.

AW ORDINANCY TO PROVIDE FOR A SURCHARGE OF FIFTY
PER CENT ON THE EXFORT DUTIES OF CUSTOMS DURING THE
YEAR 1918.

BH IT FHACTED by the Governor of the Colony of the Falkland Islands with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Export 1918 surcharge Tariff Ordinance, 1917, and shall be read as one with the Tariff Ordinance, 1900, as amended by the Tariff (Export duty) Amendment Ordinance, 1915.

Surcharge 50% on export dutics of Customs. 2. In addition to the duties of Customs payable upon the export of the several kinds of produce mentioned in the third Schedule to the Tariff Ordinance, 1900, as amended by the Tariff (Export Duty) Amendment Ordinance 1915, there shall as from the 1st day of January mineteen hundred and eighteen be charged levied and paid unto His Majesty His Heirs and Successors for the use of the Colony additional duties of Customs mentioned in the said Schedule in respect of any or all produce exported during the year 1019, or produced within the year and exported thereafter.
