FALKLAND ISLANDS.

To

The Honourable

The Treasurer and Collector of Customs.

Licence is hereby granted to any Person or Company licensed under the Whale Fishery Ordinance, 1908, or under the Seal Fishery (Dependencies) Ordinance, 1909, or any Lessee of land granted for the purpose of carrying on whaling or sealing operations in the Colony of the Falkland Islands, to export, subject to the following proviso, on and from the 1st day of October, 1919, whale oil and seal oil from the Colony to any destination other than that of a Government of Country at war with His Majesty the King.

Provided that where any such Person or Company or Lessee as aforesaid, shall have more than fifty tons of whale oil or seal oil in stock at any one time, such Person, Company, or Lessee, shall and is hereby required subject to the provisions of the Whale and Seal Oil Export and Sale Ordinance, 1917, to deliver in and to sell such oil in the United Kingdom as may be directed by a Secretary of State, or by the Governor, or to arrange and agree, with one and another such Person or Company or Lessee as aforesaid, to deliver and sell in the United Kingdom as may be directed by a Secretary of State or by the Governor, an equivalent quantity of whale oil or seal oil as the case may be.

Issued under the provisions of the Whale and Seal Oil Export and Sale Ordinance, 1917, and given under my hand at Government House, Stanley, this 1st day of July, 1919.
