The Comm Agents to be instructed by telegram to transfer the £93,684... 17.11 to Research Fund?

It is to be observed that refunds will have to be made from the Research Fund of 1/6 in respect of each 5/- collected for duty. It appeared to me feasible to cable to the Comm Agents the amount to be transferred and the amounts to be refunded to each Company, which could easily be worked out on the figures given by the Treasurer. He however points out that there are the two difficulties

(a) that the permitance charge has only been estimated by him — on the assumption that the whips have received none of the duty in cash

(b) that the landing certificates in respect of South Georgia whale oil reported have either not been received here or are faulty

He is therefore inclined to think that it would be better at this stage to cable the total sum to be transferred

only. The alternative would need
a statement in the telegram to the
effect that the payments should be
made subject to adjustment if the
quantity of oil ^{to which duty was paid} did not coincide with
quantity shown in Landing Certificate.
The payment affected by ^{a variation in} the remittance
charge must necessarily be higher
