(My dear Sheffield)

As you know, we have gone ahead with the preparations for a new stamp issue for British Antarctic Territory, and Gosman is at present working on the designs. We decided against a commemorative issue so soon before a full definitive set comes out. Since returning here, I wondered whether we could bring out a commemorative issue in the Colony to celebrate the creation of new territory, but decided that this would not be quite the thing!

There is, however, a fiftieth anniversary coming off in 1962, which I think would be worth-while commemorating. In 1912 radio communications were established for the first time between the Falkland Islands and the outside world, and in 1913 the station was opened to traffic. I think we must be one of the first Colonies to have established wireless communications with the United Kingdom. I would like to bring out a commemorative issue for three values, which I think should be our three airmail ones, i.e. 2/-d for one ounce, 1/-d for half an ounce, and 6d for the air letter. Would you let me know what you think of this idea?

I hope you will have a pleasant trip to New Zealand.

Further to my letter of September 19, about the commemorative issue to celebrate the establishment of wireless communications between the Falklands and Britain, research has revealed the following:

March 27, 1912

Foundation plate for Wireless Station laid by the Governor.

September 23, 1912

Wireless communication established with H.M.S. Active at Montevideo, and Governor Allardyce sent the following telegram via H.M.S. Active to the Secretary of State - "Please convey to His Majesty loyal congratulations of Colonists Falklands on establishment of wireless communications with H.M.S. Active at Montevideo"

Contact was later made with Rio Grande do Sol, Brazil and Carrizo, Montevideo and a regular service to Europe through these stations and H.M. Ships in the area was maintained.

September 29, 1962, would be a good date for this issue.

Incidentally, I made a mistake in our airmail postage rates, which are 2/- for ten grammes, 1/- for five grammes, and 6d for the air letter forms.

With reference to my letter of October 11, I have heard that the commemorative issue is approved in principle, and I think it is not too early to consider the designs for it. A suitable day to put the new issue on sale would be September 23, 1962. I wonder what you advise about designs? I think they should be indicative of what we are commemorating, and would look best in the photogravure process. I enclose a couple of ideas, but I am not particularly keen on including a large slice of the South American Continent, for I think this would lead to protests from the Argentine. It is not particularly easy to think of something symbolical in connection with wireless, but perhaps you may have some ideas.

I have not yet seen Goaman's designs for the B.A.T. stamps, but I should think it would be a good idea to employ him also for this commemorative issue.

I have just returned from my round-the-world trip and have seen your letters of the 19th September and 11th October. It seems to me that the 50th anniversary of the establishment of radio communications between the Falkland Islands and the outside world will be an admirable subject for celebration and I shall look forward to seeing the design.

By the courtesy of the U.S. Navy I was enabled to spend some time at the McMurdo base and had the opportunity of listening in to some of their radio traffic. I was glad to find that at that time the FICOL broadcasts were coming in well but I have some queries to raise with you and have dealt with these in a separate letter. As you will realise, it was a very worth while experience for me to see Antarctic conditions for myself after dealing with this subject for some years, and my only regret is that my stay at McMurdo was not longer.



This is somewhat difficult to estimate with any degree of accuracy as the stamps will be the first Falklands (as opposed to Commonwealth wide) short commemorative issue and may or may not be attractive to philatelists. In other words we have no 'yard stick' to guide us. Presumably the issue will remain on sale for three months or when stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier? (pl. see para. 8 of folio 14 in 1212/II att.).

2. Normal local sales for three months, taking 1961 as the basis for calculation and using rounded figures, amount to 8,000 stamps @ 6d., 4,000 @ 1/- and 2,000 @ 2/-. A small percentage of these sales would be for philatelic purposes, the majority being for postage.

3. In the circumstances I suggest we order 100,000 of each denomination for sale locally with the proviso that if the Crown Agents consider the quantity should be increased in the light of their experience with the sale of similar issues elsewhere, they should increase the order accordingly.

4. It is also suggested that the Crown Agents be requested to give us an estimate of the total revenue likely to accrue from the issue, based on the average sales of similar issues in other parts of the Commonwealth. I ask this because the figure given in P. & T. Draft Estimates of Revenue 1962/63 is purely token and may well be wide of the mark.

Sir,

With reference to your correspondence with the Colonial Office regarding the Falkland Islands Radio Communications commemorative issue, Mr. Michael Goaman has been commissioned to produce three stamp designs based on the size of the stamp being approximately 36 1/2 mm x 21 mm. We have assumed that a different design is required for each of the three values 6D, 1/- and 2/- and the artists fee for this will be £120.

Mr. Goaman has been requested to reproduce the designs suitable for the photogravure process. Photographs of the radio station and various pieces of contemporary equipment e.g. rotary disc, magnetic detector, multiple tuner and valve receiver in use at the Radio Station in the Falkland Islands were obtained from the Marconi Telegraph & Wireless Co., who installed the equipment and Mr. Goaman will base his designs on these photographs.

As the stamps are to be placed on sale on the 23rd September time is rapidly running short and we have therefore arranged for Goaman to produce rough designs as soon as possible. We propose to Airmail stamp size bromides of these to you and would be glad to have your approval by cable. Goaman could then complete his finished designs which we would approve in the same way as the Antarctic Territories issue and would then send them to Her Majesty for approval.

Incidentally I see we have not discussed the Royal Portrait which is to appear on these stamps. The Annigoni which is being used for the British Antarctic Territories would be suitable and we have asked Goaman to use this, together with the St. Edward's Crown. I hope you will agree with this.

Sir,

With reference to the Falkland Islands issue to commemorate Radio Communications, I am enclosing photographs of the art work prepared by Mr. Goaman, two photographs for each value. Each design is in two colours and on this occasion the artist has prepared two drawings for each value, each drawing being in the colour which it will be printed on the finished stamp. This is not the normal way of preparing art work but it is in fact simpler for the printer since the colours have been separated for him. For each value, the design containing the portrait will fall on the background colour as shewn in the second drawing for each value.

2. The way in which the designs have been drawn makes it difficult for the normal stamp size black and white photographs to be taken as this would necessitate several photographic processes for each design involving considerable expense and possible delays. The colours for the three values will be as follows:-

- 6d. Crimson and Orange.
- 1/- Dark Green and Olive Green.
- 2/- Violet and Ultramarine.

3. I have marked the various copies with the colour to be used and I hope you will be able to obtain a good idea of the final appearance of the stamps. I am sorry there was not time to send you the art work for inspection, but in view of the short time available for this issue it was necessary to submit the art work to Her Majesty the Queen for approval, only sending you the photo copies to catch the boat sailing from Monte Video on the 25th April.

4. I would be grateful for your cabled approval of the designs.

NUMBERING AND INTERLEAVING

With the exception of those quantities specified for delivery to the Crown Agents' Stamp Bureau, the sheets of stamps are to be numbered 1 up each duty and interleaved with waxed paper.

PAPER

The stamps are to be printed on Crown Agents' Postage Stamp Paper (wood and Esparto quality) with CA (Block Capitals) watermark. It is noted that you will require 5,000 sheets in size 56 cms. x 57 cms. Long direction grain, with watermark and greater stretch in the 56 cm. direction.

- (2) Delivery of completed stamps is to be 4/5 weeks after receipt of approved proofs.

PRODUCTION OF PRINTING MATERIAL

The production of the printing material and of the stamps is to be carried out at the usual premises of the contractor under the control of the Chief Controller of Stamps, Netherlands Government, to whom all negatives, plates etc., as well as the stamps are to be delivered.

These stamps will not be inspected by the Crown Agents. They therefore rely upon the contractor for a high standard of production, for elimination of imperfect sheets and for special selection of the best sheets available to meet the quantities specified for delivery to the Crown Agents' Stamp Bureau.

The Contractor is to hold the stamps insured against fire risk for their manufactured value until they leave his premises. Suitable lock-up accommodation is to be provided by the contractor on his premises for the storage of negatives and plates and other material in the custody of the Chief Controller.

Renewal of negatives, plates etc., as and when required to be free of cost. The stamps are to be packed in suitable tin-lined cases and wired under the supervision of the Chief Controller. Packing cases extra at cost.

Colour proofs in the colours decided are to be submitted to the Crown Agents in quadruplicate for approval before printing is commenced.

755 additional stamps of each value are to be provided for use by the Crown Agents.

As is well known the stamps failed to connect "Darwin" on 30<sup>th</sup> (actually 31<sup>st</sup>) August & the date of release had to be extended until 5<sup>th</sup> October. The B/AA estimated the air freight at £50 but the bill amounted to £98-10-11 (Jolis 83 + 8). The stamps were despatched in two air consignments - one on 27<sup>th</sup> August which should have connected "Darwin" on 31<sup>st</sup> August & the other on 5<sup>th</sup> Sept. long after "Darwin" had sailed. I cannot understand why it was necessary to air freight the second consignment. The air freight cost £72-4-6. There was no urgency about this consignment which could well have been sent by sea.

Gentlemen,

According to our records it was in 1960 that we last reported to the Colonial Secretary in the Falkland Islands about stamp publicity and this was in connection with the new definitive issue. For that reason we think that a report on our publicity campaign for the Radio Communications commemorative stamp will be of interest.

The issue was announced in Stamp Bulletin No. 355 and featured in No. 356. The specimens and descriptive leaflets forwarded to us from London were distributed with a release to all stamp magazines published in the U.S.A. and Canada and to some in South America. Releases, specimens and leaflets were also sent to writers of stamp columns in about 100 newspapers circulating in the U.S.A. and Canada.

The attached sheets of cuttings marked J and N will give some idea of the coverage obtained. In some cases the Stamp Bulletin article is quoted in full. In others the correspondents, through lack of space, can use only the wording of our release. In any event, we regard this kind of publicity as particularly important in the U.S.A. where so many collectors tend to concentrate on stamps of their own country. It is intended to supplement - not to replace - the dealers' individual advertisements.

Displays of the stamps were arranged in the foyer of the British Embassy in Washington; at the Philatelic Galleries at Trois Rivieres, Quebec; at 18 British Consulates in the major cities of the U.S.A. and in the window of B.O.A.C. headquarters on Fifth Avenue in New York.

Copies of the leaflets were also sent by special arrangement to all members of the Queen Elizabeth II Commonwealth Collectors' Society. In addition, supplies were sent for distribution at the Toronto, Canada Stamp and Coin Club Exhibition which was held in November.

Will you please be kind enough to pass a copy of this letter to the Government for information.

## 50th ANNIVERSARY OF RADIO COMMUNICATIONS COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE

5th OCTOBER 1962



To mark the 50th Anniversary of the Falkland Islands Radio Station, the Falkland Islands Government will release on 5th October, a special issue of three postage stamps.

All three stamps include the Annoni portrait of Her Majesty the Queen and the St. Edward's Crown and feature designs symbolising communications. The 6d. value shows a morse key, the 1/- value a two-valve receiver and the 2/- value a rotary spark transmitter.

The Call-Sign—V.P.C.—has been used by the Falkland Islands Radio throughout the past fifty years and it is shown in Morse Code on all three stamps.

### PRINTING

Printed in two-colour photogravure by Joh. Enschedé en Zonen of Holland on CA (block capitals) watermarked paper in sheets of 60 stamps.

### SIZE

Vertical format 40 mm x 24 mm. perforation to perforation.

### COLOURS

6d. Crimson and orange.

1/- Dark green and olive green.

2/- Violet and ultramarine.

## RADIO COMMUNICATIONS IN THE FALKLAND ISLANDS

On 23rd September 1912 wireless communication was established with H.M.S. "Active" at Montevideo and a telegram was sent by the Governor to the Secretary of State for the Colonies, a message conveying loyal congratulations of the Colonists Falklands to H.M. the King. Later on, communication was established with Rio Grande do Sol, Brazil and Carrito, Montevideo and a regular service to Europe through these stations and H.M. Ships in the area was maintained.

The installation in 1912 was by Marconi's Wireless Telegraph Company who supplied the photographs used on the stamps. It was a 5 kilowatt set with a synchronous disc discharger, the type of spark transmitter then in general use. There were still some years to go before valve transmitters came in. A 70-cycle alternator was driven by a 15 h.p. slow-speed oil engine. For reception there were two types of equipment—the magnetic detector with multiple tuner and one of the early valve receivers. The aerial system was a two mast arrangement. The station was designed to operate over a range of 500 nautical miles by day, but considerably more by night, and on a normal wavelength of 1200 metres.




