With reference to the Governor's saving telegram No. 95 dated 20th November, 1963, addressed to the Secretary of State for the Colonies agreeing to participate in the general omnibus issue of postage stamps to commemorate the Centenary of the International Telecommunications Union on the 17th May, 1965, arrangements are in hand to commission an artist to produce a suitable design. It is the intention that the issue should be produced in two colour litho which should be effective for the relatively simple design required, and will also keep production costs to the minimum. The cost of the design, which will be in the region of £200, will be divided between the 30 territories who have agreed to participate.

It is noted that the quantities required are as follows:-

- 1d. value - 25,000 stamps
- 2/- value - 15,000 stamps

It is ^{noted} ~~assumed~~ that these are for local use and a further 75,000 stamps of each value have been added for the Stamp Bureau.

I.T.U. CENTENARY:

I enclose for your information, a copy of a letter which the Secretary-General of the I.T.U. has issued regarding the preparation of stamp albums to contain examples of all the stamps issued by the countries participating in the I.T.U. Centenary Commemorative Stamp issue. The earlier letter referred to in the Secretary-General's letter was not sent to you because his original proposals were not made under the instructions of the Administrative Council.

2. The I.T.U. Administrative Council at its 20th session agreed that 2,000 such albums should be produced and the I.T.U. have therefore asked that territorial Postal Administrations should supply 2,000 of each of the stamps which they are issuing free of charge. In return one copy of the album which is to be prepared will be given free of charge to each administration supplying stamps. A certain number of the albums will be put up for sale but it does not seem possible for the Overseas Territories to take advantage of this offer, since the Ensemble as a whole, which is in the one unit contribution class, is limited to purchase a maximum of six copies.

3. The Crown Agents are able to supply 2,000 copies of each of the stamps issued by your Administration from Stamp Bureau stocks. The I.T.U. request could therefore be met and there would appear to be no significant expenditure involved. In the circumstances there seems no objection to meeting the I.T.U. request for this goodwill gesture and unless you inform me to the contrary by 10th September, 1965, the Crown Agents will be instructed to supply the stamps to the I.T.U. accordingly.

4. This circular has been addressed to the Governors of Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, British Guiana, British Honduras, Falkland Islands, Fiji, Fiji (SOPAC), Gibraltar, Hong Kong, Mauritius, St. Helena and Seychelles; the High Commissioners of Aden and the Protectorate of South Arabia, the British Antarctic Territory and the Western Pacific; the Administrators of Antigua, the Cayman Islands, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Christopher,

St. Lucia, St. Vincent, Turks and Caicos Islands and the Virgin Islands; the Resident Commissioners of the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Colony and New Hebrides; H.M. A copy has been sent to the British Government Representative for transmission to the Government of Basutoland.

1. I wish to refer to circular-letter No. 3324/61/AEI of 8 June 1964 regarding the possible issue by administrations of commemorative postage stamps on the occasion of the ITU Centenary.
2. I am pleased to report that the idea has received wide support and that, according to the information which has so far reached the Secretariat, about 100 countries are going to issue in all more than 200 stamps. The suggestion of making albums which would group all the stamps issued in this circumstance therefore deserved appropriate consideration and the Administrative Council, at its 20th Session, decided that it should be implemented.
3. The great majority of the countries having agreed to supply to the ITU free of charge 2,000 of each of the stamps they are issuing, the Council decided that 2,000 albums should be made. As regards the distribution of these albums the Council has decided as follows :
 - a) One copy is to be offered to the Head of State of each country, to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and to the Director-General of the Universal Postal Union;
 - b) One copy will be given free of charge to each postal administration having supplied stamps for the albums;

- c) Two copies will be given free of charge to each Member or Associate Member of the ITU;
- d) The remaining albums will be sold at the rate of 90 Swiss francs per copy in accordance with the following arrangements :
 - i) Copies will be distributed in accordance with paragraphs 4 and 5 to Members and Associate Members of the ITU against payment;
 - ii) Members and Assistants participating in the 20th Session of the Administrative Council, together with the elected officials of the Union, will each have the opportunity if they so desire to purchase one copy;
 - iii) Fifty copies will be set aside for distribution by ballot among ITU non-elected serving officials who, on 17 May 1965, have five or more years continuous service with the Union, the albums being purchased by officials successful in the ballot;
- e) A limited number of copies will be retained for distribution, together with any unsold albums, in a manner to be decided by the Council at a subsequent session.

4. After consideration of quite a number of factors, the Council decided to offer the various countries the opportunity to purchase copies of the album up to the maximum number indicated in the table below :

Class of contribution to the expenses of the Union (in units)	Maximum number of albums which can be purchased
30	40
25	35

15 and 18	25
8, 10 and 13	20
2, 3, 4 and 5	10
1/2 and 1	6

5. I consequently have the honour to ask you to let me know by the end of this year at the latest how many copies of the album your Administration wishes to buy at the rate of 90 Swiss francs per copy and within the limit resulting from the figures mentioned above, on the understanding that copies are going to be given free as indicated in paragraph 3 a), b) and c) above.

6. It is expected that the albums will be ready some time next year. I would like to take this opportunity of informing you that they will be prepared on behalf of the ITU by the Swiss Administration and that the stamps offered by the various countries should be sent to the following address :


