POSTAGE STAMPS:

INTERNATIONAL CO-OPERATION YEAR COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE

The United Nations will be issuing a set of commemorative stamps for the twentieth anniversary of the United Nations and to honour International Co-operation Year. It has been recommended that Member States should consider issuing a stamp or a series of stamps with the same design as the United Nations stamp, as a commemorative issue of their own.

- 2. It has been proposed that there should be an "omnibus" issue for Overseas Territories on the lines of the Freedom from Hunger and Red Cross issues. The issue would incorporate the basic design prepared by the United Nations Secretariat. The name of each territory will be shown on its own issue. The issue would be of two stamps one with the lowest denominations in use, i.e. the nearest equivalent to either a penny or half-penny as the case may be, and the other with the rate used for airmail postage. The stamps will be on sale for three months. The actual date of issue will be partly determined by the time required for printing but is likely to be either in February or in September so as to avoid a clash with the ITU issue, which is due on 17th May.
- 3. We should be glad to receive by telegram answers to the following questions:-
 - (a) Does the Government of your territory wish to participate in this issue as described above?
 - (b) What are the relevant rates for airmail postage and the lowest value? And all 6 d 7 1d
 - (c) How many stamps of each value does the Government require for local use?
- 4. We should be grateful if the Governors of Fiji and St. Helena would also reply in respect of Pitcairn, Ascension and Tristan, as appropriate.

- 5. Should the Government of Brunei decide to participate, we should be glad to know whether they will wish the portrait of the Sultan to be included instead of that of the Queen.
- 6. This circular savingram has been addressed to the Governors of Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, British Guiana, British Honduras, Falkland Islands, Fiji, Gibraltar, Hong Kong, Mauritius, St. Helena, and the Seychelles; the High Commissioners of Aden and the Federation of South Arabia, Basutoland, Bechuanaland and Swaziland, British Antarctic Territory, and the Western Pacific; H. M. Commissioners, Bechuanaland, and Swaziland; the Administrators of Antigua, Cayman Islands, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Kitts, St. Lucia, St. Vincent, the Turks and Caicos Islands, and the Virgin Islands; the Resident Commissioners of Basutoland, and the Gilbert and Ellice Islands and New Hebrides; and the British Commissioner and Consul, Tonga.
- 7. It has been sent under cover of a separate savingram to the High Commissioner for Brunei, for onward transmission to the Government of Brunei.
- 8. It has been sent to the Governors of the Gambia and of Northern Rhodesia for information only.
