

We have on display in the Post Office the current definitive stamps of the Falklands, South Georgia, and British Antarctic Territory, and have various others that are not on view to the public. As a lot of people visit the Post Office I think the appropriate place for stamps to be displayed is the Post Office.

Larger frames could be constructed by the Public Works Department, and securely affixed to the wall and we would have all the stamps together. The stamps could be displayed above the Private Letter Boxes.

I am writing to confirm that the Bureau has taken a stand at the International Philatelic Exhibition Hafnia 76 to be held in Copenhagen from 20 to 29 August.

2 In addition, a display of your stamps will be entered in the official class.

3 The organisers (in conjunction with the Danish Post Office) have approached me with a request to help in obtaining Post Office Uniforms for display at the exhibition. It is the hope of the organisers that they will be able to show the uniforms of all the Post Offices involved in this exhibition. Already, the Post Offices of Canada, France, Japan and the USA have agreed to loan uniforms, and we feel that it would certainly be a good public relations exercise if you would loan either a complete uniform (if available) or perhaps simply a Postmans Badge.

4 We would be pleased to forward the uniform to Denmark and arrange its return.

5 Your early reply advising whether you are prepared to make such a loan would be appreciated.
