Postage Stamps - Decimalisation

It is the intention that decimalisation of our stamps should be effected in two stages. The first stage will consist of overprinting the current Definitive Issue; the second stage will consist of a fresh printing of the Definitive Issue with decimal values in place of current values. As you are aware, decimalisation is to be introduced in February, 1971.

2. It will be appreciated if you will now give consideration to and in due course, after such consultation as may be necessary with other persons, make firm recommendations as to

- a) decimal equivalents for each current value of stamp;
- b) whether any individual value could or should be dropped as a result of decimalisation (e.g. perhaps the 5½d value);
- c) the advisability of taking the opportunity offered by the introduction of decimalisation to have an Air Letter value of the equivalent of 9d.

3. In addition your advice will be welcome regarding the practical steps to be taken/...

taken, in collaboration with the Crown Agents, to ensure that the overprinted issue and the newly printed issue with decimal values are available in good time; it would be helpful if your advice upon this aspect could be accompanied by a projected time schedule for the operation.

Decimalisation has been worrying me for a considerable time. I tried to find out what the G.P.C. of Britain were doing but they had not made any positive moves or had much to offer me in the way of advice.

Decimalisation will have to be tied to the postal rates structure which in turn will need a decision and approval of Government, and in my opinion the blessing of the G.P.C.

If you agree I would like to come and discuss this with you early next month.

SUBJECT :- Decimalisation

I attach a table as requested in your memo of 3rd July. Column 5 shows the stamps for overprinting and column 6 the decimal denominations. This takes into consideration (a) the minimum foreign letter rate ($6\frac{1}{2}d$) that we can have as opposed to our present rate of $5\frac{1}{2}d$ and the rates that must follow with a $6\frac{1}{2}d$ letter rate; and (b) the need for a 9d air letter rate rounded to 4p.

South Georgia Postally I can find no justification for a South Georgia issue, bearing in mind that it was only in 1944 that South Georgia had its own stamps. They were then a flourishing community of 3 land whaling stations and thousands of whaling personnel. Now it is little more than an Antarctic Base with contract officers.

Falkland Islands stamps could be used in South Georgia without overprinting. Records of sales would be readily available from this office.

This would (a) reduce the number of definitive sets of this area from 3 to 2 and (b) make it much more convenient for the Post Office as regards sales, storage space etc.

If it is not possible to dispense with the South Georgia issue then it should have the same values as the Colony issue and the same number of stamps. The current South Georgia issue has 15 stamps and it would be an appropriate time to omit the 10/-

The Colonial Treasurer has informed me that the $\frac{1}{2}$ d can no longer be taken into consideration as the $\frac{1}{2}$ d is being withdrawn.

The $6\frac{1}{2}$ d foreign letter rate was a straight conversion introducing $2\frac{3}{4}$ P etc. The Colonial Treasurer thinks that this would be difficult for accounting for the stamps so I have drawn up what I think are the rates for a 7d letter rate getting away from quarter pence. This will make it easier for accounting and counter work; this is important because it is extremely difficult to obtain good counter clerks.

Decimalisation of Definitive Stamp Issue

Memorandum by the Acting Colonial Secretary

Previous Ref: -

When decimalisation of the currency is brought into effect in February, 1971, it will have been necessary for steps to have been taken to decimalise our stamps. The length of time which needs to be allowed for processing the 'design' and printing side of this operation is 12 months. This effectively means that decisions upon decimalisation of the stamp issue need to be taken within the next 6/8 months.

2. However, it is not only a problem of decimalisation with which we are concerned. For a number of years, certain of our postal rates have not been in accordance with the requirements of the Universal Postal Union Convention e.g., we have been operating a 5½d. foreign letter rate whereas the minimum foreign letter rate we can have is 6½d. To this foreign letter rate all other rates such as Postcards, Printed Papers and Small Packets must bear the specific ratios one to another as laid down in the basic rates of the U.P.U. Convention. The rates to Britain and Commonwealth countries are not subject to the U.P.U. Convention. It is desirable that these anomalies should be put right as part and parcel of the decimalisation exercise. In addition, a decision which has been contemplated for some time needs to be taken to revise the stamp value to be utilised for the air letter form, which in most countries is now 9d.

3. Attached hereto, as Annexure 1, is a schedule setting out conversion tables, decimal values required and stamps of the definitive issue to be over-printed, the whole being based on a 7d. foreign letter rate as the datum point.

4. The Colony is obliged to clear its proposals regarding the decimal values for the Definitive Issue with the G.P.O. in Britain as Britain is a Member of the U.P.U. In view of this, the proposals contained in the attached Schedule have been forwarded to the G.P.O. for comment, a copy of them being sent to the Crown Agents in order to keep them in the picture since the exercise of decimalising our stamp values will be conducted through them.

5. In view of the limitations of the time factor referred to earlier in this Memorandum and the increasing pressure there will be upon Security Printers from now until the introduction of decimalisation it is an integral part of these proposals that decimalisation of our stamps should be done in two stages, the first consisting of over-printing with decimal values of the Definitive Issue and the second, at a later date, consisting of substituting decimal values for sterling values.

6. This paper is circulated for the information of Members. A formal action Memorandum will be prepared for Council when the comments of the G.P.O. in Britain have been received.





I agree that the 1½p overprint is not clear in its present position and think your suggestion that the overprint should appear between the two flowers above would be much more satisfactory.

I also agree that the 25p would be better if placed immediately to the right of the present sterling value.

I would also like to suggest that the 3p value is not very clear in its present position. I think it would show better if the 3p were placed either immediately to the right of the sterling value or further to the left of the position in which the printers have put it.

I am sorry not to have returned the file to you sooner, but I was tied up with preparations for the Winter Show.

Minutes of meeting held at Government House on 11th May, 1971.

Present: His Excellency the Governor (Chairman)
The Colonial Secretary (Member)
The Superintendent, Posts & Telecommunications Dept., (Member)
The Officer in Charge, British Antarctic Survey (Member)
The Postmaster (Member and Secretary).

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the possibility of
(i) a commemorative issue for the Colony during 1972, and
(ii) the issue of the Colony decimal tablet stamps in 1973.

The meeting commenced with His Excellency stating that he wished item (ii) discussed first.

The Officer in Charge, British Antarctic Survey, said that although it had been proposed at one time that the new British Antarctic Territory definitive issue, depicting Antarctic Explorers, should be released in 1972, he now had information that the issue was planned for 1973.

In view of this, it was agreed that the Colony decimal tablet issue (which was not particularly attractive in its overprinted form) should be brought forward and released on 1st May 1972.

The question of the replacement of the £1 stamp to be considered in the light of the available art work or other material, and discussed at the next meeting.

Consideration was given to the subject for a suitable commemorative issue for the Colony and among the suggestions were -

Birds - a conservation thematic issue which might at some future date be run in conjunction with the British Antarctic Territory and South Georgia.

Ships

Mail services

Map and settlements

Kelp

Battle of the River Plate (35th anniversary in 1974)

External air service.

With the South Georgia commemorative issue, and the British Antarctic Territory commemorative issue continuing into 1972, plus the Colony's decimal tablet issue, it was agreed that in the interests of rationalising issues, no further issues should be contemplated for 1972.

It was agreed that should an external air service be inaugurated, it should be the subject of a commemorative issue to take precedence over any other Colony commemorative.

Folios 77 - 78 were discussed at this morning's meeting of the Co-ordinating Committee and it was agreed ~~that~~ to proceed with the decimal value overlays to come out on 1st May 1972. 1. SILVER WEDDING ISSUES

The suggestion contained in the Secretary of State's Circular Saving Despatch No.34/71 of 8th June 1971, for a special omnibus issue of stamps in the Overseas Territories to commemorate the Silver Wedding of Her Majesty the Queen was discussed, and it was agreed that the Falklands, South Georgia, and British Antarctic Territory should participate.

Further information was to be sought regarding the types of borders to be embodied in the stamps.

2. CHANGE OF DESIGN IN 1972 OF THE £1 STAMP OF THE COLONY DEFINITIVE ISSUE

In view of the absence of suitable art work, and the fact that the Colony would participate in 1972 in the Silver Wedding issue, and considering the adverse criticism engendered by similar changes in the B.A.T. and South Georgia issues, it was decided not to change the £1 stamp.

It was agreed that this did not preclude a change of design at a later date.

3. SOUTH GEORGIA NEW DEFINITIVE ISSUE 1974

Initially, this issue was to feature the whaling industry and had reached the stage of art work. Sir Cosmo Haskard had informed the Crown Agents in August 1970 that the choice of whaling as a definitive theme for South Georgia could well be regarded as inappropriate in view of the fact that whaling from South Georgia ceased in 1965, but thought that the whaling illustrations might form part of a historical definitive issue.

The art work was viewed and it was decided that very little would be suitable for a historical issue.

The meeting agreed that ideas should be sought locally without delay for a historical issue, as well as seeking the advice of the Crown Agents and Messrs Chr. Salvesen of Leith.

4. COMMON FRANK FOR B.A.T. BASES

The Officer-in-Charge, British Antarctic Survey, said that the idea to simplify the handling of philatelic mail by using a common frank for all Bases had been investigated by his Head Office by seeking the opinions of leading stamp dealers who considered it unwise to adopt such a procedure.

It was pointed out that the UPU Convention requires a date stamp to bear the name of the office of franking.

In view of the information obtained it was agreed that no further action should be taken.

5. COLONY DECIMAL TABLET ISSUE RELEASE DATE

The Superintendent, Posts & Telecommunications, stated that for financial reasons it had been suggested by the Treasury that the release date should be the 1st June 1972 in order that all revenue would accrue within the financial year 1972/73.

The meeting agreed to the release date being 1st June 1972. The new date to be notified to the Crown Agents in due course.



1971 Decimal Definitive Overprint

I refer to your letter H2/1010/49/399 da. not at all but received 16th. Sept. 1971; and to the accompanying folder of press cuttings on the a/n issue of stamps by this Territory.

2. Usually, I read these folders with interest and pleasure, but on this occasion my pleasure is somewhat alloyed by the nature of some of the press comments apparently made in U.K. provincial and national newspapers on the fact that, instead of making our decimal definitive issue a new one coincident with our adopting decimal coinage, this Territory chose to issue an overprint of its current definitive stamps, to be followed just over 12 months later by a completely new definitive issue, viz., the floral on 29th. February, 1972, a long-considered programme finalised by my reply to FOC Tel. No. 114 as long ago as 15th. August, 1969.

3. Several of the cuttings show, however, evidence of a syndicated news-feature suggesting that Tristan da Cunha, along with our ~~other~~ friends in the Falkland Islands, South Georgia and British Antarctic Territory, "had been caught on the hop" in this matter; while the "Financial Times" strikes its own note with: "Considering the amount of planning which has gone into the decimalisation of stamps everywhere else it seems reprehensible that Tristan (which relies heavily on its philatelic revenue) should resort to this expedient."

4. Obviously, these "experts" do not realise we made an entirely new printing. I should be glad to know where you think the "on the hop" inspired comment came from; and whether you feel you can - perhaps through the Stamp Gazette - publish something that might set the record straight.

120C In advertising the new definitive issue I have stated that there will be no official FDCs (as is usual with definitive issues). This is done in order that anyone wishing to prepare their own covers may do so.

I do not like the idea of suddenly reversing this decision because the Crown Agents have come up with a request for FDCs. If the Crown Agents had considered this long ago then plans could have been made and a cover designed and they could have affixed stamps and sent them out for franking in the usual manner. They could have let us have unfranked covers and then collectors here could have put what stamps they wished on the cover, as some like a short set on a cover rather than a full set which can be expensive.

If we contemplated this we would have to employ someone to affix the stamps. We couldn't prepare covers for the Crown Agents without giving the people of the Falklands a chance to purchase them as well. Unstamped covers cause confusion in the Camp as did the departure of Gt. Britain covers.

Taking everything into consideration I am against the idea at this late date of having official FDCs and suggest that the Crown Agents are advised accordingly. They could be advised also that we would gladly consider an official FDC for our next definitive issue if this is raised in good time so that a suitable design may be agreed on.

I dislike the idea of preparing FDCs but also dislike the idea of £400 slipping away!

It is easy for the Crown Agents to say please prepare X number of covers. Crown Agents employ people to affix stamps when commemorative FDCs are made up but this is normally 4 stamps to a cover; with the definitive issue it is 13 stamps to a cover; the envelope has to be a long one to take all these stamps. We could not undertake this task in office hours.

In the words of a Colonial Office circular the Post Office should not subordinate the work of the postal services to providing philatelic services.

It is too late now to start haggling with Crown Agents over the price but if I can get someone to prepare them, then the buyer from Crown Agents is going to get a cheap cover - just the face value of the stamps is all that is going to be paid; nothing for the envelope or work of affixing stamps.

I understand there are no long white envelopes in Stanley but we do have stocks that we could use but not beyond 500. We would of course have to indent for more.

I can find someone to do this outside office hours for £15.00 i.e. 500 covers with 13 stamps for £15.00 This is a tedious job calling for care and patience; stamps have to be carefully torn and carefully affixed so that the finished article looks attractive with stamps affixed symmetrically.

Funds exist under the Head XIII xv Mail Sorting Allowances and Overtime.

If approval is given for payment then we can tackle the job and stamp sales will benefit by £415.00. I consider the price of £15.00 to be very fair.

Postage Stamps(Definitive Issue) - Reprints

With the change in local postage our sales of 2p stamps has naturally increased. Crown Agents were only able to supply us with 20,000 from Bureau stocks and have asked whether a reprint is required. We will certainly require additional stocks of 2p stamps (and perhaps others) to last until the new definitive issue is released in 1976. The forthcoming commemorative issues that include a 2p stamp will take care of about 9 months supply but I estimate we will require another 160,000 to last until July, 1976. In this particular case I don't think interleaving is necessary but it would be advantageous to have the sheets numbered.

I estimate the cost of this reprint to be in the region of £500. No provision has been made in the current estimates for reprints of the present definitive issue but without a doubt other denominations will require reprinting. Crown Agents have already asked us to supply them with 2p and 1p denominations - stocks are therefore in short supply in London. Perhaps Crown Agents should be asked what reprints they envisage during the present Financial Year.
