1. THE OPENING OF THE NEW AERODROME
2. TELECOMMUNICATIONS
3. CENTENARY OF THE FIRST POSTAGE STAMPS

Further to your telegram of 29 March regarding the opening of the new aerodrome we wish to enquire whether you are yet in a position to forward the rough designs for this issue. If this issue is to be released this year it is now important that you supply these designs as soon as possible to avoid delay.

2 We understand that you wish to have an issue to commemorate both the 10th anniversary of the telephone link and the 60th anniversary of the opening of Fox Bay radio station. As this issue is at present scheduled for release in 1977 we should be grateful if you would supply any reference material you have as soon as possible. The exact date on which the 60th anniversary of the radio station falls would be extremely helpful and might prove a realistic date for releasing this issue.

3 In your letter of 19 January 1976 you kindly informed us that you were in the process of obtaining the photographs of the old post offices. If you have now decided to have post offices as a theme instead of the red and black franks we should be grateful if you would confirm this and forward any reference material you have as soon as possible to enable the artist to commence work on the designs.

4 We understand from your letter of 27 February 1976 that the conservation issue is to feature dolphins and the release date may be postponed for a year or so. Even if the release date is postponed it would still be necessary to have the rough designs in this office fairly shortly. This would enable us to commence work on the production of this issue to avoid any later inconvenience. If Mr Strange is not in a position to produce these designs it would be possible for us to commission an artist in the usual way.

5 We look forward to receiving your early reply on the points raised above.

2.2.0 TELECOMMUNICATIONS ISSUE

2.2.1 5p Members thought the stamps as depicted were not quite what we wanted as the circles did not indicate adequately radio symbols. The preference was for the original design showing East and West Falklands with stations depicted with radio signals, including morse call signs. This design has been used by the Crown Agents for the First Day Cover.

2.2.2 10p Ship to Shore. Members were satisfied with this provided the circles were removed and more realistic radio signals inserted. The Postmaster produced a photograph of the Fox Bay Station. It was decided that this should be sent to Crown Agents who should be asked if they could incorporate it - with a ship and radio signals, instead of circles.

2.2.3 20p The wording was wrong - should be "International Telex and Telephone Service 1967/77.

Design: the point of emphasis should be moved to Stanley instead of Fox Bay. Otherwise Postmaster could approach Mr. M. Peake for advice and/or suggestions for a better design.

2.2.4 First Day Cover: Good, but wording wrong. Should be "Falkland Islands 60th Anniversary of Internal Communications 10 years International Telex and Telephone Service". Fox Bay and Stanley should be picked out by name, and circles omitted. Latitude and longitude lines should be extended and degrees marked.

Thank you for your letter of 14<sup>(12)</sup> September.

The designs have been considered and the following suggestions are made:

- 5p it is considered that this is not quite what we would like which should be based on the original design of East and West Falklands with the stations depicted, with radio signals emanating therefrom which should include the morse call signs of Fox Bay (VQZ) and Stanley (VPC). It is also thought that the circles do not adequately portray radio signals.
- 10p Ship to Shore. This is acceptable provided the circles are deleted and more realistic radio symbols inserted.  
I enclose a photograph of Fox Bay Radio Station which should be incorporated if at all possible.
- 20p The title should be "International Telex and Telephone Service 1967/77".

A local artist has produced a design that we think more suitable which should be substituted with a similar idea of lines radiating to place names, although these could be reduced in number by naming the continents.

First Day Cover This is acceptable provided:

- i) the wording is changed to "Falkland Islands  
60th Anniversary of Internal Communications  
10 years International Telex and  
Telephone Service."
- ii) the point of emphasis should be moved to Stanley instead of Fox Bay;
- iii) the circles are substituted by more descriptive radio signals;
- iv) the latitude and longitude lines should be extended and degrees marked;
- v) Fox Bay and Stanley should be shown by name.



... I am pleased to enclose for your approval three finished stamp designs together with a finished First Day Cover design for the above issue. The ~~three~~<sup>four</sup> rough designs are also enclosed for comparison.

These designs have all been amended as requested in your letter of 4 November 1976 with the exception of the "Ship-Shore Communications 1917-1977" for which you wished the photograph also enclosed to be incorporated into the design.







## Telegrams from Crown Agents regarding forthcoming Stamp Releases

(a) Telegram dated 25th April

The suggestion by Crown Agents would result in a very cramped release programme. As you know I am not in favour of having two commemorative issues on sale at the same time. In my opinion 4 new issues in 6 months is too many and is probably more than we can adequately cope with. Is the Cape Pembroke Airport to be officially opened this year? A deferment to 1978 would certainly ease the situation. It is a pity the Flying Boat Issue has taken so long to get off the ground but in the circumstances I can see no alternative but release the Communications Issue first.

(b) Telegram dated 19th April

We have agreed to the 5p and 10p Telecommunications stamps, I therefore see no objection to Crown Agents approving the final proofs on our behalf. We did not approve the Crown Agents design for the 20p stamp and submitted an alternative drawn by Mike Peake. Crown Agents artists should be able to improve on Peaks drawing but I don't like approving designs without at least seeing the first art work from Crown Agents - we should be cautious on this point I feel. I suggest the following denominations - 3p, 11p and 40p. All three can be tied to actual postage rates, the 3p and 11p will be widely used if my postage recommendations are accepted.

  - 40 pence - This value shows the International Telex and Telephone Service with a symbolic design illustrating the way in which these two services cover the globe.

---

The Falkland Islands lie in the South Atlantic, some 480 miles north-east of Cape Horn. The islands number some 200, with the two large islands, East Falkland and West Falkland.

The foundation of the communication services which the Falkland Islands enjoy today, were laid down by Governor William Lamond Allardyce, who served from 1904 to 1915. What proved of particular value to the Falklands was the erection of a wireless station on October 23, 1913. A few weeks later, the station performed its first public service when the mailship "Oravia" struck the Billy Rock at the entrance to Port William.

The communication system was continued by Governor W. Douglas Young, appointed in May 1915. Both West Falkland and East Falkland Islands were linked by radio, but further work was halted due to World War I.

Today the Government operates a broadcasting station at Stanley on 536 and 2370 Khz, with a power of 5 kw and 500 watts respectively.

External telecommunications traffic is handled by the Government wireless station in Stanley, which is in daily contact with London, Montevideo and Buenos Aires. Stanley has a telephone system to which most East Falkland farms are connected, and there is a similar service on West Falkland, centered on Fox Bay.

Traffic between the main islands and contact with farms on the smaller islands is by radio telephone. On October 1, 1974, Cable and Wireless Ltd. assumed responsibility for all external communications.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS STAMP ISSUE

Thank you for your letter of 22 November expressing your concern at the omission of Sea Lion Islands from the recently issued 3p stamp.

I am sorry that you have been worried about this and I understand your concern. However I should point out that the stamp is part of an issue featuring telecommunications, and, as such, its design was never intended as an accurate map of the whole of the Falklands, giving details of all islands, settlements, names etc.

The intention was to mark the establishment of radio communications between East and West Falklands 60 years ago - a considerable achievement which must have been a great boon to people living then in the Camp - and to highlight the part that the Camp and communications play in the lives of the people of the Falklands. The artist's idea was to focus attention on the two main communication centres of Fox Bay and Stanley, using a sketch map showing only these two names. Although he seems to have got in rather more outline detail than this, the omission of Sea Lion and some other Islands has no other significance; their absence does not detract from or lessen the importance of your island, or any other place that may not have been shown.

I hope this explanation dispels any fear you may have had that no importance is attached to small islands or to people like yourself and your family who live and work so hard in these isolated places. Nor, may I add, is there any complacent unawareness of the difficulties you have had in recent months with your own "communications"; I hope things are now better in this regard.

I am copying this letter to the Hon. A B Monk, to whom I see you copied yours, and to the Hon. D S Evans, who also took the matter up with the Chief Secretary.


