Hon. Col. Sec.

Submitted. On receipt of the telegram dated the 3rd inst., I endeavoured to ascertain where this vessel was from and where she was bound. Calls from the W/T. Station met with no response until the vessel anchored in port William at about 7.30 p.m. on the evening of the 3rd inst. At about 8.30 p.m. I received a message from the Master asking that a boat be sent for mails as he intended leaving at daylight mail delivered or not. I referred the matter to the Ag.Harbour Master who proceeded to make arrangements to get the mail, this was done at about midnight.

2. It is unfortunate that there was no information as to where this vessel was from or where she was bound as an opportunity of sending a mail to the S. Shetlands has been missed. I report this matter as the Whaling Officer, S. Shetlands, applied for a further quantity of postage stamps and will probably not understand why they were not forwarded by the "Thor Minor". I understand that the Harbour Master informed the Master that there was some mail from the S. Shetlands, but the Master stated he could not delay and the vessel sailed at daylight on the 4th inst.
