

## 17 Rare Plants

Release approximately May 1984. Presumably if the plants are extremely rare, there will be few references outside the Falkland Islands, and this would appear to be more suited to a local artist. However, if you have particular plants in mind, it may be that British experts at Kew or the Natural History Museum may have suitable material.

Advice to be sought from local experts. It was thought unnecessary at this stage to form a design committee and that pending local advice, applications be invited from interested local artists to produce artwork for such an issue.
