





Please refer to paragraph 2 of your letter of 9 February.

2. We note what the FCO say about the likely position of Dependent Territories after 1979. Notwithstanding this we still feel that, even if we are just members by virtue of the full membership of the UPU by the UK, there can surely be no objection to the Falklands commemorating the centenary of the UPU, which I believe to be the oldest, and probably the most effective international organisation in the world. We comply with all the rules of the UPU as ratified by the UK and feel proud to be part of the ensemble.

3. I attach designs which we think portray the spirit of the UPU Convention by using all possible means to deliver mail. We are not too sure about the fourth design showing the emblem of the UPU with an early Falkland Islands frank, or whether the issue should be of three stamps with the UPU emblem in the corner of each stamp. We hope to produce a Postmarks issue in 1981 so we will need to watch that we do not repeat ourselves.

4. I should be grateful for your further thoughts on this issue. I am copying this letter to the Hong Kong and General Department of the FCO as you may wish to discuss this further with them.

Thank you for your letter of 20 April 1978 (reference PH1/FALK IS 7/01834) with which you enclosed the rough designs for the proposed issue of postage stamps in Falkland Islands to mark their 100th Anniversary of membership of the Universal Postal Union.

Good

Further consideration in the interested departments here has been given to the question as to whether it is appropriate for UK Overseas Territories to have "UPU" stamp issues in the same year that their separate membership gets voted out of the Union. As we find however that the arguments in favour of the proposal outweigh those against we do not intend to raise any objection either with the Falkland Islands authorities or any other postal administration wishing to mark this particular anniversary with special stamps.

✓

Concerning the rough designs for the Falkland Islands we have the following observations. As the three designs showing the method of transport of the mail will need to carry either The Queen's portrait or the Royal Cypher we suggest that the UPU symbol, reduced to appropriate size, should also be used on each stamp to counter-balance the Royal Insignia.

As to the fourth design we agree with Mr Morrison that it may not be advisable to use the early Falkland Islands franks at this stage and prefer either a completely fresh design to be used or that the set should be restricted to three denominations.

The artwork is returned herewith.



Undoubtedly, you would have received by now a copy of Miss Nora Farrell's letter of the 24 April, informing us that the Foreign & Commonwealth Office has no objection in principle to you releasing a commemorative set of stamps marking the Falkland Islands' Accession to the UPU.

I understand you aim to release this issue early next year, therefore, it is important that a decision is made on the number of values the set is to comprise so that the theme can be properly developed, and the finished artwork prepared.

✓ We consider the theme 'Mail Delivery in the Falkland Islands' to be a good choice because apart from its obvious relevance to the UPU, it reveals an interesting aspect of life on the islands. The three rough artworks featuring three of the methods of mail delivery by 'plane, pony and schooner are potentially most attractive because of the simplicity of their design. A fourth stamp in this set could show another means of mail delivery. For instance you could depict a local post-box or, alternatively, the postman collecting mail from the docks or taking the mail to the Post Office for sorting.

✓ We think it is a good idea to show the UPU emblem on each stamp design. The Royal Cypher or Queen's portrait would, of course also appear.

In your correspondence, you did not name the artist of these rough sketches and we do not know whether it is your intention to commission this artist to produce the finished artwork or whether you would like us to commission one of our own artists in the UK. Will you please let me know who is to be commissioned so I may write to the artist explaining the size of artwork required and other specifications for printing purposes.



Please refer to your letter PH1B/FALK IS 7/01834 of 18th May.

2. I attach the art work by Mr. Peake for your examination. I must say that these are not what we would describe as finished art work; and you may wish to advise me on this as there is the question of payment to be considered. My first thought was that we should not pay for these at the finished art work rate.


3. There are amendments we would like undertaken on the art work but, as we are within 14 months of releasing the issue, perhaps you could have the following amendments carried out -

- i) we think the name Falkland Islands is too large and obtrusive, it should be reduced in size and set along the top of the stamp in one line;
- ii) in order to convey the meaning of the issue the inscription "UPU Centenary" should be inserted above the UPU symbol; the years "1879-1979" could remain beneath;
- iii) the inscriptions "Mail by Beaver Aircraft"; "Mail by Horseback"; "Mail by Schooner Gwendoline" should all be reduced in size;
- iv) if at all possible the value tablets should be placed in the bottom right or left hand corners.

4. One thing we wish to ensure is that Mr. Peake is given full credit for the designs i.e. if your artist makes minor amendments, we think it is only right that Mr. Peake is described as the artist. You may recall that the Mail Ships definitive was really designed by John Smith, but Granger Barratt was described as the designer.

5. If there are any other alterations you think are necessary to improve the issue please do not hesitate to let me know.

The proofs from Questa are very disappointing. The subjects, are I think, acceptable but the colours are all wrong. Colour wise the 3p is perhaps the most acceptable but the 25p stamp looks more like a yacht in the Bahamas! While I agree the colour of the water and the sky on the 11p stamp is perhaps typical Falkland Island it does not blend to give a good impression on the stamp. The grass is also too green. The UPU Symbol should be much more prominent on all stamps - after all this is the central theme of the issue and on the 11p and 25p stamps the symbol can hardly be seen. The inscriptions should also be made more prominent - on the 3p and 25p especially they are virtually unreadable. The value tablet could also be made more distinct.




Arrangements for lock-up or special stowage were made at the time of shipment, and it is suggested that an officer be detailed to meet the vessel on arrival to ensure that the goods receive careful handling during discharge and delivery.

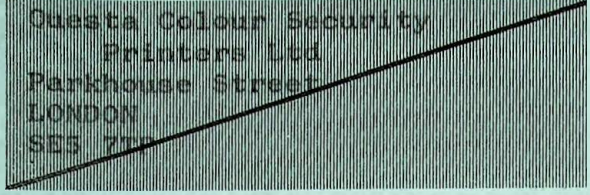

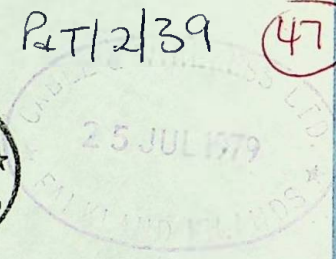

Subject:- U. P. U. Issue

With reference to the CA telegram of 24th instant regarding despatch methods for the stamps of this issue, I would suggest the entire stock is airposted.

Local requirements for a first day of release would be 17,000 x 3p, 17000 x 11p and 13,000 x 25p. These figures represent stocks required for the Stanley and Fox Bay counters, 5,500 sets for FDC's and approximately 5000 sets for Philatelic Bureau customers. Expected incoming stock from the CA is 40,500 x 3p, 29,000 x 11p and 15,000 x 25p.

It may well be possible to despatch by sea the outstanding balance but in the event of the vessels sailing being dealyed etc we would find the stock received by air would become exhausted before the arrival of the balance by charter vessel. As two packages would be required to despatch the stamps in this manner we would probably end up paying as much as having the entire stock airposted.

FDC envelopes for this issue were received by the June charter vessel.
