

One point I would like to make concerning the diversion of the "AES" is that we feel very strongly that she should go to SG Gater her call at Stanley.

The timetable is very tight in any event but is becoming impossible in our view if she diverts to SG on the southbound voyage. Even if the stamps and covers are ready for shipment on the "AES" bringing them here first would provide us with an opportunity to prepare FDCs while the ship is actually unloading and loading here. If they are not ready in time the possibility of getting them in by air in time for shipment to SG on the northbound voyage. Further we consider it may be necessary to send Coutts to SG to prepare and cancel the covers on site and this can only be done if the ship visits SG. Diverting northbound rather than southbound gives us a little breathing space - something we badly need:

As you will be aware, there has been considerable speculation recently that an announcement from Buckingham Palace concerning the wedding of HRH Prince Charles is imminent. As heir to the throne and future titular Head of the Commonwealth there is bound to be considerable international interest in the Prince's wedding and it will undoubtedly be commemorated philatelically by many countries, especially as stamps portraying members of the Royal Family form one of the most popular subjects thematically speaking.

With this in mind we have already formulated detailed plans for an omnibus issue of stamps on similar lines to the Silver Jubilee and Coronation Anniversary sets of 1977 and 1978 respectively. These will be communicated to you should a wedding be officially announced but in the meantime you may like to know that we shall be recommending that the total face value of each country's set should equate to 75 pence sterling.

To assist us in the vital preliminary work which is essential if this probject is to be operated to the optimum effect in terms of impact and revenue, we shall be grateful if you will confirm, in principle, that Falkland Is, Falkland Is Dependencies and British Antarctic Territory wish to participate in the proposed omnibus issue.

Advance planning for the actual production of the stamps is, as said previously, a crucial factor to the ultimate success of such a project but, if we are to achieve the best possible philatelic sales, a co-ordinated advertising campaign is also essential. In this regard, we believe that there may well be only a relatively short period between the announcement and the wedding.

We have been considering how best to proceed with this and have concluded that much of the success of the Silver Jubilee and Coronation Anniversary omnibus sets was attributable to the advertising undertaken by some of the larger stamp dealers. You may recall that on these occasions you agreed to donate quantities of your stamps which we distributed to dealers against firm

promises that they would undertake advertising to at least the equivalent of the face value of the stamps provided. This is an extremely economical method of achieving widespread coverage at minimal cost since the effective cost is that of the "run on" cost of the printing of the extra stamps; a matter of pence rather than pounds. If you agree to participate in the proposed omnibus we shall be grateful for your approval in principle for an extra five thousands sets of stamps to be produced and distributed by ourselves in the manner which we consider to provide the best potential for increased sales. We shall of course promote the omnibus extensively in all of the suitable media but feel that the extra advertising which could be undertaken by the provision of "stamps in kind" will be amply rewarded by the additional revenue which is likely to accrue from extra sales.



PRINCE CHARLES OMNIBUS STAMPS ISSUE

I refer to my telex of 24 February announcing our intention to release an omnibus issue of stamps to commemorate the marriage of His Royal Highness Prince Charles to Lady Diana Spencer. I am pleased that you accepted our recommendation and have agreed to an issue for Falkland Islands.

The actual wedding date has been announced within the last few days and the wedding will take place in St Pauls Cathedral on the 29 July 1981. However, it is possible that this will be declared a public holiday in the United Kingdom and we therefore recommend a release date on 22 July. This date has been chosen, not only because the British Post Office will release its set on that day, but for sound financial reasons also. Many thousands of visitors to London are expected for the royal wedding occasion and we believe that they will wish to buy an attractive souvenir as a memento. Thus, stamps displayed and available at stamp dealers shops during the preceding week should be readily saleable with consequent improved revenue to Government.

As mentioned in my original telex, it will be necessary for us to approve all the designs and proofs on your behalf in view of the lack of time, although we will send you a photocopy for your information. Indeed, we will send you a photocopy of your particular artwork within the next few weeks, as soon as the artwork is completed, but, meanwhile you may wish to receive a set of colour photographs which we had taken from our rough preliminary sketches which were produced while our plans were being formulated. As you can see, the original sketches are indeed extremely rough but I hope that they will convey to you the overall format of the set. Incidentally, the tridents depicted on two of the stamps are based on an idea which has now been dropped.

#### Low Value

As mentioned in the telex, this is to portray a traditional English wedding bouquet but consisting of the flowers of your country, surrounded by an heraldic garland which is common to all three values. The background to the stamp is to be of a pale lilac. Unfortunately the photograph has a rather blue tinge to it and in fact the actual background colour is more like the colour of the top orchids within the bouquet.

#### Middle Value

This is to depict a photograph selected from a series we have located to convey the many facets of "a man of our time". I have pleasure in attaching to this letter a colour photocopy of the actual photograph which we have selected for use on your stamp. At one time it was considered wise to enlarge the overall area within the heraldic garland to ensure that the scene was portrayed clearly. However, it is felt that this detracts from the uniformity of the set and, therefore, on the final artwork the heraldic garland will be in the oval format as illustrated on the photographs of the top and bottom values. The background colour for this middle value is to be a yellow to simulate gold. The photograph shows a grey background but this is now to be for the top value for reasons that I will explain later on.

#### Top Value

Please ignore the rough sketch of the couple which is contained on this stamp. This is not the photograph we will be using. We have located one of the many photographs that were taken on the day the announcement was made and the printer will reproduce directly from the photograph to ensure a good likeness of the couple. Since Lady Diana Spencer was wearing a blue dress on the day of the announcement and His Royal Highness Prince Charles was wearing a dark blue suit, it was decided that the grey/silver background would look better on the top value complementing the blues of the clothes the couple were wearing. Therefore, the top value will have a grey background to simulate silver similar to the background shown on the rough design for the middle value.

#### Heraldic Garland

I have briefly mentioned above that the heraldic garland on all three stamps will be in the oval format. The garland is an heraldic fantasy based on the Order of the Garter. On the left-hand side are to be found the heraldic devices shown in the order of the garter which is worn by His Royal Highness Prince Charles. To the right-hand side of the design is a "fantasy garter" including the 'fret' and 'escallop' from the coat of arms of Lady Diana Spencer. The whole garland is surmounted by the feathers of His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales.

10 March 1981

As specified in my telex, the stamps are to be printed in the normal format of 50 stamps per sheet set in two panes of 25 stamps. The central gutter which appears between the two panes is to contain an heraldic gutter design printed in black only. I enclose herewith a photocopy (which is slightly reduced in size) showing roughly how the final sheet will appear.

As, of course, you are aware, there is an increasing demand nowadays for collectors to purchase the gutter pairs of stamps (ie the stamps on either side of the gutter). You will see from the photocopy that the central gutter design does not repeat itself and therefore each of the five gutter pairs contained in the sheet will be slightly different. In view of this we expect that we will receive large orders from dealers to purchase the gutter strips only from the sheets of stamps. Of course, wherever possible, we will encourage the dealers to take full sheets of stamps, remove the gutter strips for sale separately and use the remainder of the sheet to meet their normal sales of complete sets. However, we have received firm enquiries from a few of our major dealers to purchase complete sheets of stamps in the usual way but also to purchase the gutter strips only in addition to the full sheets. The actual manufactured costs for producing one sheet of stamps for this issue will be a maximum of 15p whereas the sale of the 10 sets of stamps from the centre of the sheet constituting the five gutter pairs will amount As you will see, the revenue to be made from the sale to £7.50. of the gutter strips only will be extremely profitable since the manufacturing cost of the whole sheets of stamps is minimal by comparison. In view of this we propose ordering an extra 4,000 sheets of stamps of each value from which we will sell only the gutter strips which will result in an income from revenue of £30,000.00. After the sale of the gutter strips we will be left with the panes of 20 stamps from either side of the sheet which will be held together with our stock. Although, of course, we will endeavour to supply some of these against orders for individual sets that we receive, it is unlikely that these will all be sold and we therefore propose that these extra are destroyed.

Turning now to a completely different aspect of this issue, I would like to refer to the First Day Covers which are being produced. I enclose a colour photograph of the rough First Day Cover design. Once again this was prepared when we were formulating our ideas and we included a typical engagement ring rather than the actual ring given to Lady Diana Spencer by His Royal Highness Prince Charles.

Royal Stamp Booklet?

/We .....

We are endeavouring to locate a suitable photograph of the royal engagement ring to include on the final designs and will send you a photocopy of the final artwork when prepared. For past omnibus issues the Crown Agents have sometimes offered to arrange for the affixing of stamps to First Day Covers. However, I would imagine that you could arrange for local labour to affix the stamps in Falkland Islands. Should it prove extremely difficult for you to arrange this locally then we will of course help wherever possible but we have to advise you that our current charge is £8.50 per 1000 stamps plus 10% handling charge and no doubt you would be able to arrange for the stamps to be affixed to the First Day Covers locally for a smaller fee.


To summerise briefly the points I have raised above, I list below our intentions:-


- 1. The release date for this issue should be 22 July 1981.
- 2. We will approve artwork and proofs on your behalf but send photocopies to you for your information.
- 3. We will order extra stamps to accommodate orders for gutter strips and the excess panes of 20 stamps remaining will be taken into stock and destroyed on withdrawal of the issue in view of the great deal of revenue that can be earned from the sale of gutter strips.
- 4. The stamps are to be affixed to the First Day Covers by local staff in Falkland Islands.

I trust that you are in entire agreement with the proposals I have outlined above and that you receive the enclosed colour photograph safely. Of course, if it is finally agreed that BAT and FID will participate in the omnibus, we will have to work very fast; Janice Smith is currently awaiting a reply to her telex of 4 March and I trust that by the time you receive this letter a firm decision will have been advised.



The Chief Secretary opened the meeting by explaining to Members the proposals for the Prince Charles issue and how far the Crown Agents had progressed with the planning. Our set would be 75p based on the three stamps suggested by the Crown Agents with a common design for the First Day Cover.

The Chairman explained the efforts being made to enable the Falkland Islands Dependencies, and the British Antarctic Territory also to participate by arranging for a ship to call at South Georgia late in June and exploring the possibility of flying in stamps to the British Antarctic Territory.

Members agreed on the designs for the three stamps and hoped that, if possible, H.R.H. should be shown in Navel uniform on the 25p stamp, and that the issue could be linked to the Falkland Islands by means of local flowers for the bouquet.

The type of wedding bouquet was discussed at length: members recommended that we should ask the Crown Agents if they await a reply from us or whether they have this in hand. There are no really suitable indigenous flowers for bouquets but Members agreed that if possible the bouquet should contain "pale maidens" to give it local flavour.

Members also considered the use of special cancellation cachets suggested by the Crown Agents and agreed to the proposal and agreed to the Prince of Wales feathers being featured on the cancellers.





Obviously, we are going ahead with all possible speed, since we are left with very little time (the finished artwork for most of other Principals are well on their way to completion). Luckily, during the months of speculation leading up to the announcement, we had purchased copyright on sufficient photographs of the Prince of Wales to have a small surplus - I enclose a colour photo copy of the one which I had earmarked for FID.

Please refer to John Hayball's letter of 10 March, concerning the Falkland Islands' issue; the contents of this letter apply in the case of the FID issue, with the following changes:-

- (a) The First Day Cover design now features St Paul's Cathedral rather than the engagement ring.
- (b) The question of affixing stamps to First Day Covers is dependent on the method of despatch presumably if the covers are to be sent from Stanley, you can affix the stamps, but if the "AES" diverts to South Georgia during its journey from London to Stanley, we would obviously have to affix the stamps ourselves.

I believe there may be only five or six people at South Georgia this winter and I cannot see four of them cancelling FDCs at any one time; indeed we would prefer to have this task carried out by the BAT postal clerk in the interests of maintaining the high standard required. We require two (the second in case the first develops a fault) cachets and these have already been ordered. The wording on the cachets k should be "Falkland Islands Dependencies - South Georgiath. This is the agreed and well-established designation of this Post Office. I cannot understand BAS' obsession with "Grytviken" which I believe is the name of the old whaling station across the bay from King Edward Point on which the present BAS installations stand. The Post Office is in the Falkland Islands Dependency of South Georgia and as it is the only one in that Dependency it is unnecessary to assign a more local geographical designation to it.

The correspondence on this subject indicates yet again the need to establish whether Dr. Adie or I is postmaster to FID (and BAT I suppose).



THE WEDDING OF HRH THE PRINCE OF WALES AND LADY DIANA SPENCER

On 24 February 1981, an announcement from Buckingham Palace read :-

"It is with the greatest pleasure that the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh announce the betrothal of their beloved son, the Prince of Wales to Lady Diana Spencer"

which brought out cheering crowds in London. It was later announced that the Royal Wedding would take place at St Paul's Cathedral on 29 July 1981. This day was to be declared a national holiday in the United Kingdom.

- 2 Charles Philip Arthur George, Prince of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Prince of Wales and Earl of Chester, Duke of Cornwall and Rothesay, Earl of Carrick, Baron of Renfrew, Lord of the Isles and Great Steward of Scotland, Royal Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, Royal Knight of the Most Ancient and Most Noble Order of the Thistle, Great Master of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath and Knight Grand Cross of that Order, was born on 14 November 1948. His parents, from his earliest years, ensured that his life was full and varied.
- In 1957, Charles became a boarder at Cheam School in Berkshire, after a short time in a day preparatory school in Chelsea. At school he was granted no special privileges, achieving the anonymity necessary to a normal education. In 1962, he went to Gordonstoun, a Scottish school with an emphasis on physical toughness and self-discipline. In 1966 he spent a short time at Timbertop, an up-country annexe to Australia's exclusive Geelong Grammar School, returning to Gordonstoun to become head boy. In the following year Charles became an undergraduate at Trinity College Cambridge, and after his investiture as Prince of Wales, gained a degree in history in 1970. followed several months at the Royal Air Force College, Cranwell, improving his flying. He transferred to the Royal Navy, developing his abilities as a helicopter pilot and eventually attaining command of a 360-ton minehunter, HMS Bronington in 1976. After 5½ years of service, Prince Charles left the Navy to play an important part in the 1977 Silver Jubilee celebrations, chairing the Jubilee Appeal Fund.
- 4 Lady Diana Frances Spencer, the youngest daughter of Earl Spencer, spent much of her childhood as a neighbour of the Royal family at Sandringham. Her father, an equerry both to King George VI and the present Queen, owns an estate in Northamptonshire. It was natural that she should accompany the Royal family on holidays to Balmoral, at first as a companion to Prince Andrew. It was only after she had left school that Lady Diana was seen more in the company of the heir apparent. Before her engagement, Lady Diana worked in a kindergarten, living with several girl-friends in a South Kensington flat. Lady Diana is in fact distantly related to Prince Charles, being his seventh cousin once removed, related directly through William Cavendish, third Duke of Devonshire (1698-1755).
- 5 The couple intend to live in Highgrove House near Tetbury in Gloucestershire, a distinguished Georgian house standing in superb park -lands in the Duke of Beaufort's Hunt. It is 90 miles from Buckingham Palace, an easy journey by helicopter.

On no account should airfreight for Falkland Islands be routed via Montevideo as there is no direct link with Port Stanley. Such airfreight has to backtrack to Buenos Aires giving rise to delays and additional charges. Normal route is via Buenos Aires and Comodoro Rivadavia. If this consignment attracts additional charges through being routed via Montevideo do you wish us to accept these on you behalf on a reimbursement basis.

Ag. C. S.,

I submit draft response to telegram from Unicover Corporation. Routing airfreight via Montevideo can give rise to both delay and often considerable additional capress as you may recall from your Treasury days. We have repeatedly told Unicover and other American firms to route it directly to Stanley mentioning, if they must, Buenos Aires and Comodoro Rivadavia. I think it is as well to warn them of the possibility of additional charges and see if they wish us to accept them. We do not want to get landed with such charges and then spend the next two years trying to sort it out as we did in the not too distant past. Depending upon Unicover's reply I will tip off the Treasury for possible charges coming through in the Macstaple accounts.
