A personal letter to A. Crieghton Esq. head of the Animal Husbandry Department, Rowett Institute was despatched by the s.s. 'Falkland' on April 4th. Several suggestions regarding peat mould experiments, and tussac seed planting were made, and it was also suggested that analysis of peat mould and tussac grass would be of much interest.

A short description of the work done in this Colony was given, and it was requested that a report on the experiments at Aberdeen be forwarded to the Falkland Islands, that His Excellency might compare results obtained in Scotland with those obtained in Government Paddocks.

I regret that no copy of this letter was made, as it was written in the evening prior to my departure to the West Falkland on March 29th.

A report will be submitted to the Rowett Institute on the results of these experiments.
