I am replying to your letter of 27 January, addressed to Mr. Luard, about offshore oil concessions in the Falkland Islands.

I am sending your letter on to the Colonial Secretary of the Falkland Islands who deals with enquiries of this sort, and asking him to write to you direct. Communications with the Falkland Islands are, however, slow, as there is no air service to the Islands, so that you will not get a reply for some time.

With regard to the specific questions you ask:

- (1) A topographical map of the Islands can be obtained either from the Colonial Secretary or from Edward Stanford Limited, 12/14, Longacres, London, W.C. 2. Admiralty charts of the surrounding seas can also be obtained from Stanfords, but I believe that good charts have been made by the United States Navy, and you can no doubt get these in the States.
- (ii) A basic geological map of the Islands is at present, I understand, being compiled for the Falkland Islands Government, but it is not yet completed.
- (iii) The Colonial Secretary will, I think, send you a copy of the Petroleum and Mining Laws applicable.
