Re: Application for Oil Exploration  
License, Offshore Area

On behalf of Sunningdale Oils Limited (hereinafter called "Sunningdale"), and pursuant to the Mining (Mineral Oil) Regulations 1964, we herewith make application for an Oil Exploration License covering approximately 12,000 square miles as outlined on the map enclosed in duplicate. In support of this application, we have also enclosed a typed copy of the First Schedule to the Regulations and cheque in the amount of £ 25 to cover the specified application fee.

The block for which application is being made is sometimes referred to as "The Burdwood Banks", a submarine feature having water depths of less than 100 fathoms over a large area. We have assumed that you will have jurisdiction over some portion of this Bank even though it is located approximately 200 miles to the south of the Falkland Islands, since there appears to be a reasonable physical separation from the South American Continental Shelf.

In this connection it will be greatly appreciated if you could inform us as to the current status and extent of any jurisdictional dispute that may exist in respect of the sub sea areas adjacent to the Falkland Islands. It is the opinion of Sunningdale that there are other potential hydrocarbon bearing areas worthy of exploration which may be under your control.

Sunningdale's experience in offshore exploration is considerable as you will see from the attached schedule and we believe they are



Mr. Bartley of Sunningdale has spoken to Mr. Sugg of the Foreign Office in London and we understand that the Mining Regulations may be under revision at this moment. Any information on this point will also be most helpful to us.

(7) The following represent some of the areas in which we, in association with others, are now actively exploring:

- Maldiv Islands:** We have recently obtained a concession in the Maldiv Islands to the east of your country and so far have completed preliminary magnometer and gravitometer studies. This will shortly be followed up by an extensive marine geophysical survey.
- Liberia:** In Liberia on the west coast of Africa we have completed a \$250,000 geophysical programme on a very substantial offshore holding. Additional work is being carried out at the present time through an arrangement with another company.
- South Africa:** In South Africa we are exploring three prospects two of which are offshore and all of which have had substantial geophysical work done. Through an agreement with the South African Government oil company (SOEKOR) several wells have been drilled.
- Indonesia:** In Indonesia one of our proposed partners is currently evaluating the results of a \$250,000 geophysical survey conducted during the last few months.
- North Sea:** In the North Sea we participated in the drilling of two wells within the past year, one off the coast of Norway, the other off the coast of Holland.
- Canada:** The company is significantly represented in Canada with large holdings in the Arctic and the east coast offshore.

I have to acknowledge receipt on the 9th of May of your letter of the 24th March, 1970, and to say that Her Majesty's Government is currently carrying out an investigation of all the information relating to the oil-bearing potential of the sea areas around these islands. It is expected that this investigation of existing information will take approximately 12 months. During this period it is not proposed to consider oil exploration licence applications, nor to accept financial deposits made in respect of such applications. Accordingly the cheque No. 24439 enclosed with your letter is returned herewith.

2. As you have already been informed our Mining Regulations may need to be amended. It is not possible to say more than that on this point at present.

3. Her Majesty's Government is being informed of your application and of the action taken by this government in respect of it.
