I beg to submit the following statement regarding Sub. Head 3 Stock Department - Diminution of Birds of Prey.

Expenditure in 1928.	£ 41. 3/-
" " 1929	£ 14. 17/10
" Till June 20 th 1930.	3. 19. 6.

Several stations pay 1/- per sill for Carrancas, and on these stations the Birds are rarely seen.

Only on the smaller outer Islands Green Boobies seen in any numbers. This Bird is perhaps the only carnivorous Bird biologically particular to the Islands, and it is probable that in a few years the species may become extinct.

I submit that it is undesirable to encourage extermination of this species, and beg to suggest for His Excellency's favourable consideration, that all payments effected under Sub. Head 3. Diminution of Birds of Prey, cease at the end of 1930.
